RABBI SILVER, TOP U.S. ZIONIST, ASKS ALLIES FOR MILITARY ALLIANCE
SAYS TRI-PARTITE AGREEMENT OF 1950 FAILED
WARNS WEST ARMS TO ARABS WILL NOT BUY ALLEGIANCE BUT
WILL END IN DISASTER

BALTIMORE, MD., DEC. 6.-- Pointing to the failure of the Tri-partite Agreement of 1950 to insure peace on Israel-Arab borders, and labeling Great Britain's mediation offers in the Near East "the desire to insure for itself a corridor through the Negev to Jordan and the Middle East," Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver, foremost spokesman for Zionism in the United States, tonight called upon the Western nations to give Israel the assurance of a military alliance.

Speaking to a capacity crowd attending Baltimore's 12th Annual Donor Dinner of the Zionist Organization of America, held in the ballroom of the Lord Baltimore Hotel, Dr. Silver declared:

"Allied diplomacy has at no time since the establishment of the State of Israel, seven years ago, been of the kind as to persuade the Arab States that nothing is to be gained by them in prolonging the boycotts, the blockade and the cold war against Israel. The extensive economic and political aid which has been given to one or another of the Arab States by our Government and by other nations of the free world was never made conditional upon Arab agreement to peace negotiations with Israel and for a package settlement of outstanding issues."

Over 800 Zionists attended this dinner to raise funds for the local and national program of the ZOA, one major project of which finances scholarships for needy students at the Kfar Silver Agricultural Training Institute in Negev, Israel. This school, named in honor of Rabbi Silver, teaches modern techniques of scientific farming.

Chairman Leonard Rosen, who presided over the meeting, urged Dr. Silver to give the Baltimore ZOA the benefit of his "authoritative analysis of the Middle East during the tense and dangerous days which are now facing the State

of Israel."

Dr. Silver enumerated as basic facts which must be faced in discussing the Near East situation, some nine points, the first three of which dealt with the Arab States. The first charged them with acquiring arms not to defend themselves against Russia but to prepare a war against Israel. It also asserted "Those who are hoping to hold the allegiance of the Arab States to the West by providing them with arms, are helping to build up a threatening military front, not against Russia, but against Israel."

The second fact cited stated, "The Arab States know that Israel is not threatening them....The third stated, "The Arab States will not willingly recognize the existence of the State of Israel. Their leaders have time and again publicly announced their intention to wipe Israel off the map."

Rabbi Silver, who represented the Zionist movement before the Assembly of the United Nations, reviewed past events, explaining that the State of Israel had been "compelled to arm itself because immediately upon its establishment it was attacked by the armies of neighboring Arab States in a war which they declared against Israel in defiance of the United Nations. In this war, they were defeated, but they have not abandoned their intention to launch another war at the first opportunity to accomplish what they failed to accomplish in their first onslaught. This is their clearly avowed intention. Until these states have made peace with Israel and have abandoned their intention of exterminating it, or until such time as the Western nations have given Israel the assurance of a military alliance, the young State must, as best as it can, look to its own defenses."

He further declared that "Israel desires no arms race...Israel has no expansionist ambitions; it covets nothing which its Arab neighbors possess."

But, "Israel will not purchase peace at the price of reducing its small territory of 8,000 square miles in order to augment the 1,700,000 square miles of the territories of its Arab neighbors. The Arab States require no additional territory for their well-being, but the development, irrigation and cultivation of what they have....

"Great Britain's offer of mediation on the basis of territorial concessions by Israel is motivated, not by the economic needs of the Arab States or by any moral consideration, but by the desire of Great Britain to insure for itself a corridor through the Negev to Jordan and the Middle East. Egypt's desire for

the Negev, to which it has absolutely no claim, is motivated by its wish to have a common land frontier with other Arab States, to deny Israel an outlet to the Red Sea, and to gain prestige for Egypt in the Arab world."

Deploring the failure of the Tri-partite Agreement of 1950 to fulfill its objectives -- to insure tranquility on Israel-Arab borders, pending a permanent peace settlement, and to avert an arms race -- Dr. Silver charged, "An arms race is on! And the allied nations, no less than the Soviet bloc, has encouraged this armament race."

The ninth and final point submitted by Rabbi Silver as basic to any analysis of the Middle East question was:

"Israel wants no war -- and no preventive war. It has not employed its armed forces, which according to the testimony of the Arabs have been superior to theirs, in launching any war against any of them. The Arab States can have peace with Israel any time they want it. They need not spend, and they should not be encouraged to spend, their limited resources, which ought to be devoted to the problems of wide-spread poverty, disease and ignorance among their peoples.

"The short-sighted policy of purchasing their loyalty to the democratic world by supplying them with arms has clearly bankrupt. Any attempt to compete with Russia in grants and sale of arms in that part of the world will also end in disaster. It will simply make the Arab leaders more intransigent, more ruthless and demanding. They will continue to play off the East against the West to the utter confusion of both."
