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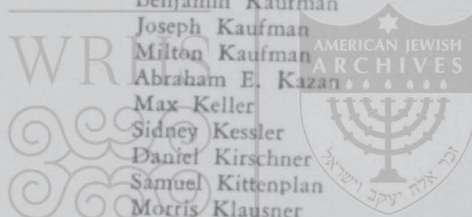
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The Jews of America have already invested more than a billion dollars and immeasurable amounts of time, energy and devotion towards UJA's unparalleled achievement of saving a people. History will note this with amazement and admiration. But history will also record our failure if we do not finish the job.

In 1955 we are running out of time. Only unceasing devotion and sacrifice can give us the time we need to save lives ~~fast~~—to save lives *now*.

We saved 750,000 refugees and brought them to Israel. But the very size of the effort was a staggering burden for a young country surrounded by implacable enemies. UJA was the key to rescue. UJA was the key to Israel's ability to develop and to absorb immigrants. UJA *remains* the key to Israel's survival as a haven of refuge and to the rescue of thousands of North African Jews who fear for their lives. UJA *remains* the key to the survival of Europe's Jewry and to the never-ending battle to keep Jews safe and free throughout the world.

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
