The widest known Rabbi in the United States and probably in the world today. Dr. Silver is the Rabbi of the largest liberal Jewish congregation in the United States. He was recently honored by Life magazine as one of the twelve leading preachers in the country. Dr. Silver is regarded as the foremost spokesman of Zionism in the country and the most influential Jewish representative at the United Nations responsible for the establishment of the State of Israel. Dr. Silver delivered the prayer at the inaugural ceremonies of President Dwight D. Eisenhower.
