





The History of Tau Epsilon Rho

In April, 1919, six men, Jerry Moss, Harry Fuerst, Jerry Neubauer, William Morrison, Ed Davidson and Leo Grossman organized as Lambda Eta Chi at Western Reserve University in Cleveland. A year and a half later, in November, 1920, Sam Deutsch, Frank Spira, J. Eugene Farber and Ernie Abram created Phi Epsilon Rho on the campus of Ohio State University.



On March 26, 1921 these fraternities consolidated as Tau Epsilon Rho and obtained articles of incorporation from the State of Ohio on April 23, 1921. This charter included the names of David P. Hyman, William Morrison, J. Eugene Farber, Frank Spira, Harry G. Fuerst, Reuben Bonds, Jack A. Persky, Leo Grossman, Jerome W. Moss, Baruch A. Feldman, Ernest Abram, Everett E. Loeb, Edward E. Lurie and Samuel Ginsburg.

Cleveland was the site of the first annual convention in June 1922, and in the winter of 1927, the first issue of *The Summons* appeared.

The first Cardozo Memorial Award was presented on February 22, 1941 to the Honorable Robert H. Jackson, then Attorney General of the United States, and today this represents a landmark in the fraternity's history. In December of the same year another tradition was inspired by the first presentation of the Sophia Schwartzberg Memorial Cup to the winner of the national Moot Court Competition.

After World War II the fraternity held its postwar revival convention at Cleveland as its Silver Jubilee Commemoration. In 1949 the annual meeting affirmed the policy that no man worthy of membership shall be denied admission because of race, creed or color. Another niche in the fraternity's history occurred on November 15, 1955 when the State of Illinois granted a charter to the Tau Epsilon Rho Scholarship Foundation.


Salutes . . .

James G. McDonald

One of America's noted authors and lecturers and this country's first Ambassador to the State of Isreal, James G. McDonald has been for many years an outstanding authority on international affairs. He was one of the founders of the Foreign Policy Association, and served as Chairman of the Board from its inception in 1919 until 1933, when he was appointed League of Nations High Commissioner for German refugees.



As League Commissioner, Mr. McDonald was one of the first to recognize the impending threat to world peace implicit in Nazi persecution of the Jews.



On his return to America, he was, successively, an editorial writer for the New York Times, President of the Brooklyn Institute of Arts and Sciences, and Chairman of President Roosevelt's Advisory Committee of Political Refugees.

In 1945, Mr. McDonald was named by President Truman as a member on the Anglo-American Commission of Inquiry on Palestine. He emerged as a champion of the rights of Jewish victims of Hitler's Europe to unlimited immigration into the Jewish Homeland.

He was appointed U. S. Ambassador to the new State of Isreal in 1948 and served with distinction two and a half years. Upon his resignation, he was hailed in Isreal as a friend who had helped cement close ties between America and the new democracy in the Middle East.

1952—To The Honorable Learned Hand, Judge, United States Court of Appeals, Second Circuit (Retired).

1953—To Dr. Harold C. Urey, Nobel Prize Winner Professor of Chemistry.




