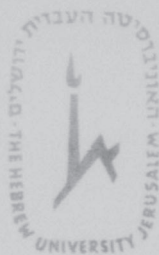

DEDICATED LEADER



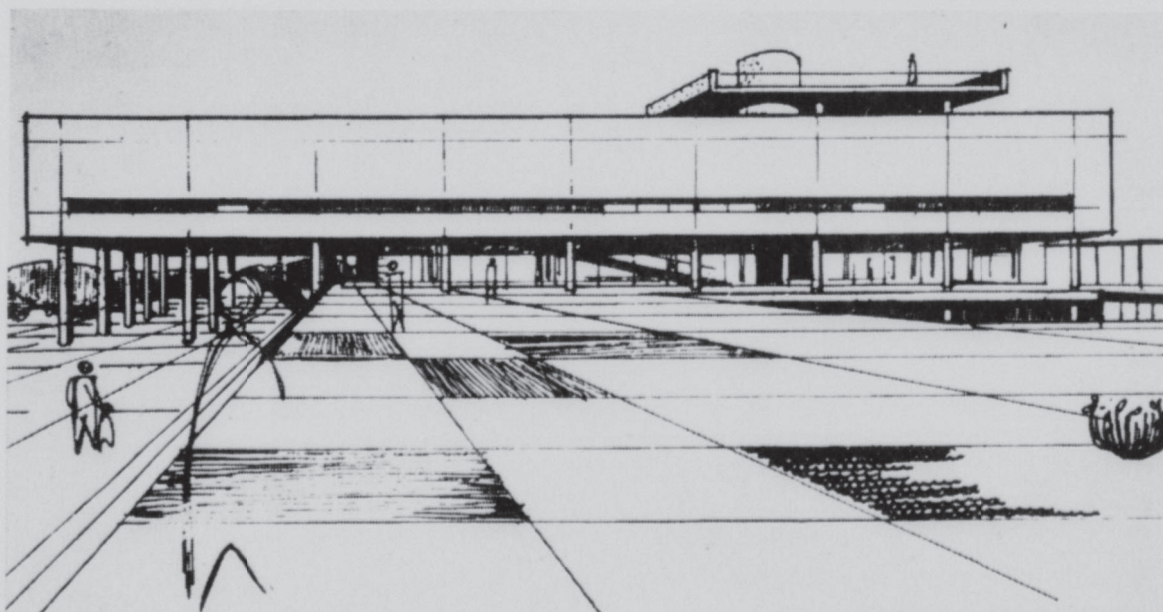
