January 22 -- DR. ABBA HILLEL SILVER

"RUSSIAN JEWRY -- AN EYE WITNESS REPORT"

For forty-four years spiritual leader of The Temple, in Cleveland, largest liberal Jewish Congregation in the United States. Has been actively identified with many social movements of our day. Served as Chairman of the American Section of the Jewish Agency for Israel, Chairman of the American Zionist Emergency Council and President of the Zionist Organization of America. Regarded as the foremost spokesman of Zionism in the U. S. Represented the movement before the Assembly of the United Nations, and is one of the leaders responsible for the establishment of the State of Israel. Delivered a prayer during the inauguration of President Dwight Eisenhower on Jan. 20, 1953. Author of many religious and historical volumes. Recipient of numerous awards. Considered one of the outstanding orators of our times. A truly great world Jewish leader.

March 13 - DR. SALO BARON

"AMERICAN JEWRY -- AUGURY FOR THE FUTURE"

One of the outstanding Jewish historians of the modern era. Occupies the Chair of Jewish History, Literature and Institutions at Columbia University. He also serves as Director of the Center of Israel Studies at that University, as well as Visiting Professor at the Jewish Theological Seminary of America. He has doctorate degrees in History, Jurisprudence and Political Science from the University of Vienna, as well as rabbinical degree from the Jewish Theological Seminary in Vienna. He is the author of numerous authoritative works on Jewish history and is a contributing editor to Unesco's "Scientific and Cultural History of Mankind. His Social and Religious History of Jews" originally published in three volumes in 1937, is now being expanded to fifteen volumes and translated into Hebrew and French.

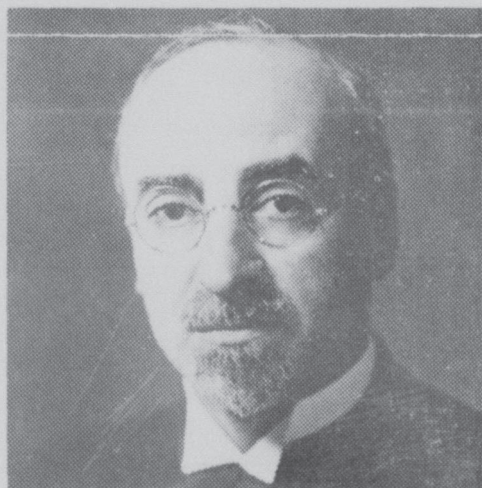


Dr. Salo Baron

April 10 -- DR. DAVID and MRS. TAMAR DE SOLA POOL

"DAYS OF DILEMMA" -- A Duologue

Spiritual leader of the Spanish and Portugese Synagogue. During World War II was the official Jewish adviser to the Army, Navy and Air Force. He is one of the founders and leaders of the National Jewish Welfare Board, and has been president of many major Jewish organizations. An outstanding author, he has written frequently on Jewish history and religion. A leader in interfaith activities, he was among the founders of the National Conference of Christians and Jews and of the U. S. O. Holder of many honorary degrees, he received his Ph. D. summa cum laude from Heidelberg University.



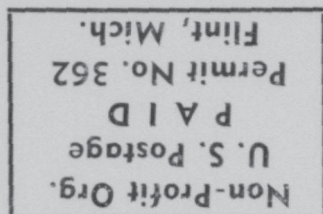
Dr. David De Sola Pool

Tamar de Sola Pool was National President of Hadassah during World War II. She pioneered in the work of Youth Aliyah and was an early proponent of the Hebrew University-Hadassah Medical School. She organized Ramat Hadassah Szold in Israel. Long active in interfaith and civic work, she has been a leader in several national and international programs. Mrs. Pool was educated at Hunter College, the University of Paris and Columbia University.

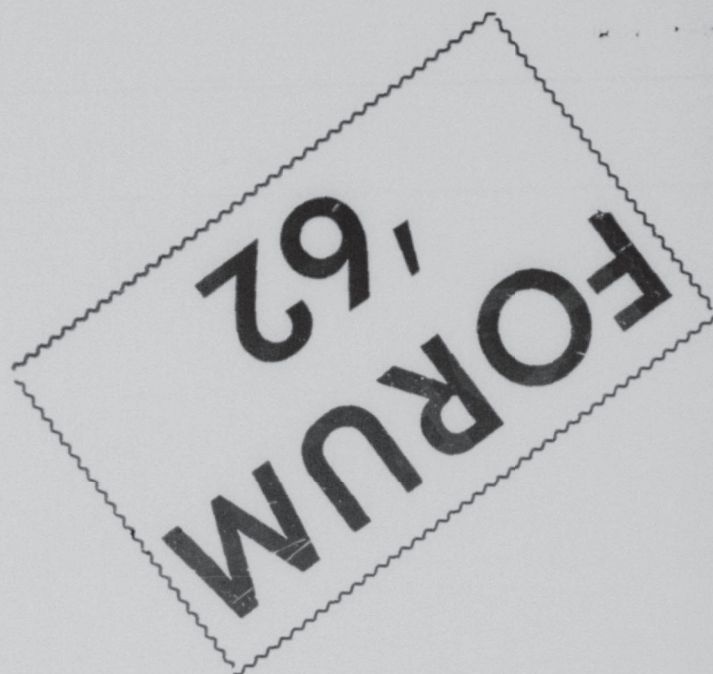


Mrs. Tamar De Sola Pool
