For some time we have been planning to have under our auspices a Catholic priest, a Protestant minister, and a Jewish rabbi. It is our idea to have them about thirty days apart, and they are to talk on post-war subjects, such as, "The Church in the Post-War Period," "When Peace Comes," etc.

We have already contracted for the appearance of Dr. Daniel Poling, and we would like to get Dr. Talbot and yourself.

It is immaterial to us which one appears on the program first.

We would like very much to invite you to appear on this program. On what date could you come, and what is your fee?

We are looking forward with considerable anticipation to your acceptance.

Dear Friend:


