EDWARD ADASKIN 287 SOUTH MAIN STREET FALL RIVER. MASSACHUSETTS December 7. 1944 Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver Temple Emmanuel Ansel & E. 105th Street Cleveland. Ohio Dear Rabbi: I had the opportunity some weeks ago, to discuss with Albert A. List, the possibility of your paying New England another visit, but this time in an official capacity rather than just as a vacationist. Temple Beth-El, of which Rabbi Rudderman. who is now in the service is our Rabbi, has just completed raising \$74,000 to pay off it's mortgage on the Temple that was built in 1928 and it is our desire to celebrate with a banquet at which 600 or 700 people will be present. I have been asked by the committee in charge to extend an invitation to you and ascertain if you would be our principal speaker that night. Realizing how hard pressed you are for time, we left the date rather open with the idea of having you advise us what Sunday in February would be agreeable to you. Fall River looks forward with a great deal of anticipation and pleasure to your visit and I personally look forward to renew our acquaintance. December 26, 1944 Mr. Edward Adaskin 287 South Main Street Fall River, Mass. My dear Mr. Adaskin: Please pardon the delay in answering your kind letter. I have been away from the city a good deal of the time and my correspondence has accordingly lagged. It would give me pleasure indeed if I were able to come to Temple Beth-El and to share with you in the celebration of its debt cancellation. I know how happy you must all be, for my people here burned their Temple mortgage just two weeks ago, and we, too, cel brated. Unfortunately I am so heavily burdened with work, and committed to so many engagements, that I cannot in justice to myself and my health take on any additional responsibilities this season.
