Inviting you months in advance of the date of the meeting, I do hope that it will be possible for you to accept our very cordial invitation.

The meeting on April 27th will be a celebration of Israel's Independence Day and will at the same time mark the completion of a six months program in this country of our commemorative tribute to Theodor Herzl.

I know it will sound like boasting, but I think we have had in Canada more activities in commenoration of Herzl Year than any other country. We commenced our program on Nevember 2nd last with a demonstration in Montreal. Emanuel Neumann was our guest speaker and I know he was greatly pleased with the meeting.

The gathering on April 27th will be held at the St. Denis Theatre - the most beautiful place in Montreal for a public meeting. This is the first time a Jewish organization has been given the use of the theatre.
