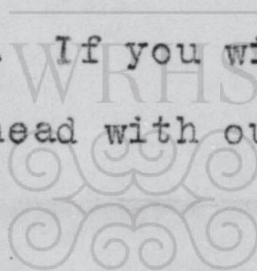
My Dear Rabbi Silver :-

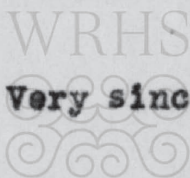


