Dear Doctor Silver;

In our community of approximately eighty Jewish families we have recently completed the building of a beautiful Synagogue, which will be dedicated on Sunday, June 8, 1958. I am writing to ask you to be our guest speaker at this ceremony, so very meaningful to us here. Knowing full well how very busy you are, nevertheless, I put aside all hesitation in asking you because in my heart I know what it would mean to our people here. This is a community in which Judiasm has been a " way of life ". In the dedication of this new building there will also be a renewed dedication in spirit and feeling.

If you can possibly give us the privlegeof hearing you on this date, a reply at your earliest convenience would be deeply appreciated. Transportation and lodging would of course, be provided. Please let me know what your fee is, as this is a consideration.

In closing, please let me say again that it would mean so very much for us to hear you speak. In our people, this building is the culmination of many dreams, aspirations, and years of hard work. In you, Dr. Silver, we would have a speaker worthy of this dream.
