Dear Rabbi:

It was a pleasure to talk to you over the telephone for the first time, and it will be an even greater pleasure to talk to you personally.

We, here in Portland, have a Federation which functions most effectively, which has now been in existence for three years, and which is the outgrowth of cooperation in former

UJA Campaigns.

This year the Federation is raising \$50,000 for the two principal agencies of UPA and JDC, and ours will be the first Campaign in the state, which through its Maine Jewish Committee plans to raise a minimum of \$150,000 for these two agencies. Thus you see that we here in Portland are depended upon to show the way for the rest of the state.

Each year we have had a national speaker, and each year we made every effert to have you with us, but had not been successful. Now we feel that this is the year for you to accept our invitation and to inaugurate the most successful campaign in our history. We here in Portland have always had a warm spot in our hearts for you, and this year we are solidly behind you in your vigorous efforts to place Zionism on a sound, public foundation without dependence on any single public personality. Personally I have already given you very leyal support.

Moreover, if you were to come, I can arrange for about 25 of the principal Zionist leaders in our state to meet with you in conference the afternoon of the banquet, and in that way you will be able to accomplish two mest worthwhile

purposes.

We will leave open the Sundays of April 15, 22 and 29, so that you may select which one will suit your convenience.
