September 24, 1935 Mr. W. F. O'Donnell. Central Kentucky Education Association, Richmond, Kentucky. My dear Mr. O'Donnell: In going through the correspondence which has accumulated during my stay abroad this summer, I came across your telegram of September 6 and your kind invitation to address the Central Kentucky Education Association on October 4. I assume that by this time you have already completed your program.
