DEAR DR. SILVER :

| AM ACTING AS A REPRESENTATIVE OF A BODY IN S ALEM, CONSISTING OF FIVE ( 5 ) PROTESTANT CHURCHES, NAMELY, FIRST UNIVERSALIST, FIRST UNITARIAN, SECOND UNITARIAN, TABERNACLE ( CONGREGATIONALIST ), AND CROMBIE STREET
( CONGREGATIONALIST ) CHURCHES, WHO ARE SPONSORS OF A SUNDAY NIGHT FORUM.

AS SECRETARY OF THE SALEM YOUNG MEN'S HEBREW ASSOCIATION ( WHICH CONDUCTS A MONDAY NIGHT FORUM SERIES DURING THE WINTER MONTHS ), I WAS INVITED TO ATTEND THEIR MEETING A COUPLE OF WEEKS AGO. AT THIS MEETING, A LIST OF SPEAKERS WANTED FOR THIS COMING SEASON WAS BRAWN UP AND YOUR NAME WAS AMONG THOSE SELECTED. THE PARTIAL LIST IS AS FOLLOWS: RABBI ABBE HILLEL SILVER, REV. JOHN HAYNES HOLMES, REV. FR. MICHAEL J. AHERN, S.J., PROF. KIRTLEY MATHER, EDWARD A. FILENE, MRS. FRANKLIN DELAND ROOSEVELT, DR. MARY E. WOOLEY, PAUL SHEARER, GLENN FRANK, WALTER SHINGIFFORD, JAMES GORDON GILKEY, PROF. SHAPLEIGH, ANTON DE HAAS, WILLIAM GREEN, PROF. FRANCIS BOWES SAYRE, GRENVILLE HICKS AND OTHERS.

JUDGE ROBERT W. HILL, Esq., CHAIRMAN OF THE GROUP, REQUESTED ME TO WRITE TO YOU INVITING YOU TO COME TO SALEM TO ADDRESS ONE OF THE FORUM MEETINGS. THE FORUM SEASON WILL START ON THE SECOND SUNDAY IN JANUARY AND WILL CONTINUE EVERY SUNDAY UNTIL MARCH 17TH, 1935 AT WHICH TIME THEY WILL CONCLUDE. THERE IS ALSO ANOTHER FORUM HELD IN DANVERS, MASS., FOUR (4) MILES FROM SALEM, HELD UNDER THE AUSPICES OF A GROUP OF PROTESTANT CHURCHES. THEY HAVE ALSO EXPRESSED THE DESIRE TO HAVE YOU SPEAK AT THEIR AFTERNOON FORUM ON THE SAME SUNDAY THAT YOU WOULD SPEAK IN SAMEM.

KINDLY ADVISE ME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE WHETHER YOU WOULD CONSIDER COMING TO SALEM AND DANYERS ON SOME SUNDAY DURING NEXT SEASON AND THE RATE THAT WE IN SALEM AND THE OWER GROUP FROM DANVERS WILL HAVE TO PAY.

HOPING TO HEAR FROM YOU FAVORABLY IN THE IMMEDIATE FUTURE, IN ORDER THAT I MIGHT GIVE A FAVORABLE REPORT AT OUR NEXT MEETING, AS I KNOW THAT WE ARE VERY ANXIOUS TO HAVE YOU DOWN TO SALEM AND DANVERS.
