Dear Dr. Silver:

Thank you for your telegram of August 17th, with reference to our request for your help as speaker during our Welfare Fund Campaign. We are well able to appreciate the fact that your commitments are heavy in times like these.

I wonder if, as an alternative, the following might be possible: I should image it not unlikely that you may be in Detroit during the coming winter. In that event, can you consider, during such a trip spending one evening across the river, in Windsor?

Your immense prestige would certainly draw a large audience from among the 3,000 members of our Jewish community. I have no doubt that our campaigns in behalf of U.P.A. and J.D.C. would benefit in considerable measure through such a meeting.

The Windsor Jewish Welfare Fund Campaign, because of its early organization and the pioneering done here in Community Council work, often sets the tone for fund-raising throughout Eastern Canada. The Windsor Daily Star is one of the most influential newspapers in Canada. For these reasons, your presence at a meeting here would have a most stimulating effect on fund-raising, as well as Jewish-Christian relations, in an area far greater than merely this community.
