My dear Rabbi Cohen:-

I feel a sense of deprivation in being denied the opportunity of participating in Cleveland's tribute to Dr. Abba Hillel Silver.

He deserves well of all right-thinking men for the work he has done for Israel. His efforts have been stamped with the approval of the United Nations which, in spite of the vagaries of our own government, gave form and substance to the creation of a new unit among the nations of the world - a unit consecrated to liberty and sanctuary.

Dr. Silver has been assailed on his personal side; he has been assailed as an American; he has been assailed as a Jew. None of these attacks is justified.

Personally, he has conducted himself with dignity; with understanding and with force.

My dear Rabbi Cohen: -

I feel a sense of deprivation in being denied the opportunity of participating in Cleveland's tribute to Dr. Abba Hillel Silver.

He deserves well of all right-thinking men for the work he has done for Israel. His efforts have been stamped with the approval of the United Nations which, in spite of the vagaries of our own government, gave form and substance to the creation of a new unit among the nations of the world - a unit consecrated to liberty and sanctuary.
