Dear Mr. Barbarash:

I am very sorry that I will be unable to attend the testimonial dinner to be given Rabbi Silver on his sixtieth birthday.

I have been one of the very great admirers of Rabbi Silver and have always felt that he represented one of the great persons that led the United Nations to partition Palestine and create the State of Israel. I happened to be a delegate from Minneapolis to the American Jewish Conferences and I remember so well the first conference held in the Waldorf-storia Hotel when Rabbi Cilver made the unforgetable speech demanding that the world should bring about the establishment of a democratic Jewish homeland in Palestine. It was one of the most inspiring talks I had ever heard. He made it at the time when the idea of a Jewish homeland was still frowned upon by a large segment of Jewry, especially since the war was going on and they felt that such a question was very untimely then. I agreed with Rabbi Silver when he made that request, and through all the struggle from then on "abbi Silver in all his statements proved to be the beacon light for those who were trying to learn the right thing to do to solve that phase of the Jewish problem.

Rabbi Silver will go down in history as one of the great men of America especially in the Jewish community, as one who has proved to be the greatest power for good in the Zionist movement.

I wish you could convey to Rabbi Silver my great esteem and admiration for one of the really great leaders of world as well as American Jewry. If there is contemplated some gift for Dr. Silver, please count me in on it.

Dear Abba Hillel:

When I received the initial invitation to come to the thirtyfifth anniversary of your ministry in Cleveland, Ohio, I gave thought to coming in person and attending the dinner. It is not that you will be shy of people, but I wanted in that way to express my appreciation for your great ministry, and I believe that the best way I could have expressed it would have been to attend the dinner in person. However, my schedule at this time does not permit it.

Rather than send you the formal note of congratulations, I wanted to tell you some of the things that passed through my mind as I thought of your historic service to the American rabbinate.

I have never forgotten the time that you visited me at college in the November of 1914, when I was a freshman and you were a senior, and I had been taken to the hospital for an appendectomy. Your calling on me made a memorable impression.

While at college, I remember the debate over the Yod Kof Tof, and your stirring address in which you coined the effective, if not elegant phrase, "That damned clean-collar briggade."

When you were in your first year in Cleveland, I was present on a Sunday morning, and heard you deliver a sermon to a huge congregation in the ald Temple. I was profoundly moved by what you had to say, and in this sermon I believe you expounded the cause of the coal miners in West Virginia, and people around me muttered, "Socialist." I liked you for both.

Then I have often spoken of that memorable incident when you resigned from the Chamber of Commerce in Cleveland in factor of the protest of the late Newton D. Baker, and the threats or the mutterings of the president of your congregation. I believe that that story should go in a book on "Social Justice Actions of American Rabbis." I also have a very vivid impression of the address you delivered one Sunday evening in New York on the eve of the convention of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations. I never heard you speak more effectively or rouse an audience, most of whom were speakers themselves, to such a high pitch of genuine religiosity.

I appreciatively remember your coming to Cincinnati to share in preparing the statement on "Judaism and a Just and Enduring Peace."

I still hear fine echoes of your meeting here in our Temple with the representatives of the press and educational institutions. Among those present was the managing editor of the Star-Times, a member of our Temple, and a man of pritical acumen. To this day he sings the praises of the effectiveness of your presentation which actually influenced thoughtful persons into changing their point of view.

Lastly, of course, you made history when President Eisenhower wiped a tear from his cheek as you mentioned his name in your prayer at the inaugural. I am sure that every one of your colleagues has similar memories of how your words or what you did touched, moved and inspired them.

May God bless you with many more years of a fruitful ministry.






