



**Goal Reached**

The one-hour long, porch to porch Mothers' March on Polio was a complete success here Thursday night. The goal was \$800,000, almost \$200,000 more than last year, and it was passed.

**Polio Vaccine**

Doctors believe a new vaccine developed at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine may be the answer to the dread infantile paralysis. Medicine seems more hopeful than ever before in the long fight.

**Prices Fall**

Falling food prices will continue the same trend in the coming months, a Press survey of food stores and home economists showed today. Milk is down 2 cents a quart. In past six weeks alone meat prices have fallen 5%. Food price index climbed most of last year, but started dropping sharply in November and is still at it.



**MINOR FURORE** was stirred up when the Ohio Junior Chamber of Commerce picked one beauty queen to reign over Ohio's 150th birthday party, but the speaker named another. Named was Janet Bailey (left), of Akron, but VOTED was Martha Zimmerman, Youngstown, both 18. The junior executives stuck by the mistake announcement.

Hardware men say the trend of householders doing own repairs, painting and general improvement is increasing and is most significant change in their business.

**Lake High**

The maximum elevation of Lake Erie in 1953 will be between 573.1 and 574.6 feet above mean New York tide. This means that if it reaches the high forecast it will be only .1 foot below the all-time high of last year, when great property damage was done along shore lines.

**Silver Fund**

With an initial check for \$40,000, the Abba Hillel Silver Charitable and Educational Fund was launched as the newest community program at a dinner in honor of the rabbi's 60th birthday.



**MRS. JEANNE BURKET**, newly wed at 23, made almost straight A's at Flora Stone Mather to graduate as Reserve's only summa cum laude in the mid-year class of 1952. She and her husband, Robert E., a Case graduate last spring, live at 1234 E. 71st.

**Asks \$100,000**

Attorney Robert J. Shoup today set \$100,000 as his fee to sparkplug through a downtown subway here. He argued: "This job would take almost all my time for a year. I won't do it for nothing. I won't do it for a small amount. Actually, the \$100,000 I'm asking is just a drop in the bucket."

**WPA to Riches**

Robert E. Stumpf dug ditches for the WPA back when. Now he owns Kitchen Maid Meats, processing sausages and the like, which grossed a million dollars last year. He's expanding, too.

**Long Step**

Use of atomic energy by the CEI to produce electrical energy is a few years off, the Atomic Energy Commission said in semi-annual report. CEI is one of 11 large companies now experimenting in the project.

**Gunman Killed**

Deputy Inspector Michael J. Blackwell killed John C. Hayes, 49, a gunman who wounded Police Capt. John Fitzgerald slightly and Robert Myers, 22, Air Force veteran, critically.

Myers was shot by Hayes at his filling station, 11834 Euclid Ave., upon no provocation. Later Hayes invaded the Fenway Hall Coral Room at noon.

**Homes Cheaper**

Home prices are past the peak, a real estate analyst reported here. He, however, did not expect big price drops, and warned there would be a "firming" in the spring.

**Look Ahead**

Turbines, gas or oil, or atomic energy may replace the Diesel on railroads within 10 to 15 years, L. L. White, president of the Nickel Plate, forecast.

**687 Graduate**

Eight city high schools graduated 687 at mid-year commencement exercises.



Dear Dr. Silver,

The occasion of your 60<sup>th</sup> birthday gives me the opportunity to express for my & heartfelt wishes. I am happy that this anniversary is for you an event without elegie sentiments. For you are still young and don't feel till to day the burden of age. I am entitled to state this, knowing your well being a doctor and examining myself who is not far from his station (This is my year too to reach this solemn moment).

To let us be very brief but very cordial, when I say - simple words that I bless with all my heart. All you do and achieve during the first period of your life is very remarkable and deserves gratitude and applause. 

Word has reached me that you have just enjoyed your 60th birthday. I wish to add my congratulations and best wishes to the thousands you have doubtless already received.


My father, Harry J. Fisher, always thought a great deal of you and were it possible to do so today, I know that he too would want to be remembered to you.




Dear Silver:





Dear Rabbi Silver:

Even though so late about this I wish to add to the great number you must have received my earnest congratulations on your distinguished achievements through most able and helpful service in many religious and public activities during your rabbinate of thirty-five years at The Temple.

During all of this time I have lived in the general neighborhood of The Temple, have been a member of your sister church, the Euclid Avenue Congregational Church, have attended many services and meetings at The Temple, have felt high, warm admiration for you as a religious leader and man, and have been proud of our having such a great man and leader in our neighborhood and community. That is why we have established the ZOA House in Israel Tourist Service (AZF) and have built the ZOA House in Israel (AZF). Nevertheless, there are some of you who will be unable to go now. To you, we offer our travel guide "So You're Going To Israel" (50¢ from our Book Shop - write us) (an AZF publication). It is light, extremely readable, and contains a wealth of travel information to help you on that "some day" when you are there.

\* \* \* \* \*

American Zionist Fund News: Rabbi Israel H. Levinthal, Chairman of the Committee on Hebrew Culture and Language (AZF) recently reported the progress of his Committee. This runs as follows: - 1) the Hebrew language should be emphasized in all speeches, at all meetings, and in all publications of the ZOA, 2) Hebrew courses in colleges and schools should be encouraged, 3) simple Hebrew should be taught by means of linguaphone-type recordings, 4) Hebrew publications should be distributed in order to assist children, grown-up youth and adults in instilling the Jewish spirit and the Hebrew language. Rabbi Levinthal concluded by saying "we want to accomplish something that will be of lasting benefit". The AZF is the pocket that foots the bill.

\* \* \* \* \*

A punchy new leaflet is ready for your use in enrolling members. Entitled "We Must Answer", it covers at a glance the menacing developments on the Communist, neo-Nazi, and Arab fronts, and what your Organization is doing in this emergency. A membership application is appended for your prospects' response. See that your District gets out among its workers for vigorous action in strengthening our ranks. (You may have the following from Membership which prepared the membership bills referred to): A new membership bill is based on the theme "The Red Haman Attacks Israel, Zionism and You!" This ought to jolt your neighbor who has not renewed his membership. See that your District orders this powerful bill and puts it to immediate use. Reminding you: 1) The February Bulletin on Program and Education has a complete round-up on the Communist Campaign against Zionism and Israel, including everything you need for your protest meeting, speakers' notes and the like. It will help you swing into active action in rousing your District and community, 2) The Purim Source Book has been sent to your District, and a Program Guide is available. If you have not seen them, we will be glad to rush them out to you.

\* \* \* \* \*

Finance offers the following comments and suggestions: 1) If any Membership Chairman, Financial Secretary or Treasurer is holding on to any membership reports, please have him forward report and remittance as quickly as possible. We need the funds daily, 2) Any AZF Chairman who is delaying the remittance of collected AZF funds is requested to make remittance immediately. The Constitution of the ZOA states in Article V, Section 5 - "All Zionist Funds shall become the property of the Zionist Organization of America immediately upon collection thereof by any Region, District, Society, person, or other agency acting on behalf of the Organization, and such funds shall either be remitted immediately to the national organization, or be placed at its disposal in accordance with its instructions", 3) Just a reminder to make all checks payable to "Zionist Organization of America" so that contributors may enjoy the tax exemption - otherwise, there will be complications, 4) Are you exploring all possibilities of raising funds such as: theatre parties, raffles, carnival, concert, etc.? Consult the excellent AZF check list for

suggestions, 5) Charitable contributions authorized in 1952 can be paid up to March 15, 1953 and still be deductible against the 1952 tax.

\* \* \* \* \*

The Commission on Israel and the Middle East (AZF) met on Sunday, February 15th at the Commodore Hotel, New York City. It dealt with plans for our ZOA activities dealing with - 1) the Communist campaign against Israel and Zionism, 2) the political situation in the Middle East, 3) American foreign policy towards Israel and the Middle East. - The Israel Government, Jewish Agency and the Press cooperated with the ZOA in these deliberations. This is part of the Campaign for the Defense of Man (AZF).

\* \* \* \* \*

The ZOA Economic Conference for Israel (AZF) which is now scheduled for March 14th and 15th is already in preparation. Discussions on the highest levels are taking place with the United States Government, the Israel Embassy and Consulate-General's office, the Jewish Agency for Palestine and prominent industrial associations. Invitations will be going out this week. It is not too late to submit lists of names to us.

It's hard work to fight! It is easy to do nothing, letting things go by the way they want to; but all proud, conscious Jews want to fight, driven by the challenges which Soviet Anti-Semitism, Arab intrigue and neo-Nazism provide. ZOA is the vehicle for that fight! American Zionist Funds and ZOA Membership are the weapons. No one stands outside the struggle, not even those who think they've managed to stay clear.

\* \* \* \* \*

The Silver Dinner in New York was a brilliant success. Chicago, Los Angeles and San Francisco are the next AZF stops for Dr. Silver. For those of you who cannot attend, the February issue of the American Zionist (AZF) is dedicated to Dr. Abba Hillel Silver as a tribute to his 60th birthday. Its leading article by Dr. Emanuel Neumann is an extensive and detailed account of Zionist activities in the past decade when, under the leadership of Dr. Silver, American Zionists made history through their successful battle to win the endorsement of a Jewish state by the United States government and the United Nations. In addition, the February number comes to grips with some of the basic issues facing Jewry today. - - - - You can also obtain the literary landmarks which reflect Dr. Silver's thinking. Our Book Shop has "Vision and Victory" (\$2.50) and "World Crisis and Jewish Survival" (\$2.00) - - - - The News Reporter edition (AZF) of the American Zionist contains a running account of the Dinner.

Israel and World Jewry: One Front

By DAVID PORTER

When the new coalition in Israel became a fact, many people in the two main parties forming it failed to recognize the extraordinary event, that brought the hitherto two rival concepts together, in an effort to form a national front. But soon enough the Soviet anti-Jewish campaign came to convince even the die-hard sceptics that this was the twelfth hour for a national salvation government — not one second sooner.

The impact of the Soviet attack was twofold: against world Jewry and against the State of Israel. The rapid developments since the "trial" of Prague, which proved to be but a subtle prelude to the main onslaught of racial hatred and frantic enmity to the State of Israel, in fact consolidated the two fronts: the Jewish front with that of the State of Israel. What we are facing to-day as Jews, as Zionists and as citizens of Israel, is one and the same reality, as dire and dreadful as the Galuth at its worst.

Again, within less than a decade, we are to face a period of rabid racial persecution, with all the physical and moral tribulations awaiting our brethren, who became entangled in the fire zone of a global conflict, and are to suffer the fate of an eternal scapegoat. As long as Jews remain in dispersion, tyrants and aggressors will always abuse their weakness to render them the victims of aggression. As a living seismograph of any impending tidal move, we can feel already the uneasy movement of forces threatening world peace and security.

For the present the Soviet move against Judaism and Zionism intends to hit two targets in a single stroke. At home, the "Jewish saboteurs" are to be blamed for all the failures, shortcomings and privations of Soviet planning. In the outer arena, Soviet anti-Semitism is to attract all Nazi and other hostile elements, in Europe and elsewhere in the West, while the Arab enemies of Israel are to be patted and cajoled into believing in Soviet "friendship". Moreover, the mock trials of Prague, Moscow and perhaps others following suit, are to convince subjects of Russia and "Democratic Republics" that all that is wrong within the confines of the Iron Curtain is the fault of the Jewish leaders, doctors and other purged intellectuals. The Germans also are to be told that Israel and the Jews have already "robbed" so much of the wealth of Czechoslovakia that they are in no need of German reparations.

Unfortunately, the policies of the Western Democracies towards all the implications of the Soviet move, both in the Mediterranean and the European scenes, are as yet far from lucid. Western statesmanship has not yet grasped the true significance of this campaign; neither have the lessons of forty years of Chatham House diplomacy

## Israel Government Warns Communists, Condemns Moscow Murder Libel

JERUSALEM (INeS). — Government action against groups in Israel supporting the anti-Jewish instigations behind the Iron Curtain was threatened in the Knesset by Foreign Minister Sharett at the close of a discussion on the Moscow medical murder libel. The House signified its assent, at the end of the speech, by voting (89:6) to refer the question to the Foreign Affairs and Defence Committee.

Mr. Sharett said in an official declaration: "Any attempt by persons and public bodies in Israel to justify or defend campaigns of anti-Jewish instigation which imperils the safety of Jews in any land will be regarded by the Government of Israel as a hostile act against all the necessary consequences will be drawn."

Mr. Sharett also declared:

"The fact that throughout the world outside the Soviet Bloc the Moscow announcement is regarded as a fabrication clearly shows that the whole affair is designed exclusively for internal consumption. Its purpose is, first of all, to frighten the great Jewish community of the Soviet Union and the Jewish communities in the States allied to it, and secondly, to prepare the population of those countries for possible reprisals against the Jews."

### WILL NOT REST SILENT

The State of Israel will not rest silent in the face of an attempt made by any power to defame the name of the Jewish people and of a danger threatening masses of the Jews wherever they may be.

The Government of Israel has regarded friendship with the U. S. S. R. as one of the assets of its international position and as a source of gratification for the whole Jewish people. It vibrates with deep sorrow and grave anxiety the pernicious anti-Jewish course officially adopted in the U. S. S. R., which must arouse vehement indignation and condemnation on the part of the State of Israel and the Jews throughout the world.

In the consciousness of the Jewish people the Moscow libel is of the same category as the charge of well-poisoning levelled against the Jews in the Middle Ages or that of the killing of Christian children for ritual purposes. It recalls to our memory the Beilis trial, staged by the Tsarist regime in 1913, with this difference, that Beilis was not forced to plead guilty, but was given a chance of being defended by the best lawyers of Russia. The people of the State of Israel and multitudes of Jews throughout the world are convinced that the accused are innocent, regardless of admissions forced from them. Similarly, all those familiar with the work of the Joint Distribution Committee have no doubt as to the purity of its activities and reject indignantly the attempt to besmirch its name.

### TURN TO U. N.

The Government of Israel will expose in the U. N. and on every platform the campaign of instigation against the Jewish people and its competent public bodies now going on in the countries under Communist rule and will raise its voice in warning of the danger which threatens millions of Jews living there.

The Government of Israel will continue to demand with the utmost vigour that all Jews who desire to seek their salvation in Zion shall be permitted to do so.

## Dr. Abba Hillel Silver - 60

In celebrating the sixtieth anniversary of Rabbi Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, Zionism honours an outstanding figure, even in a movement which from its inception has been rich in remarkable personalities.



There can be no doubt that the man who, in the years of struggle before the emergence of an independent Israel, precipitated the realization within the Zionist movement that Herzl's postulate of a

Jewish State was a real and immediate aim, and not merely a pious wish to be politely camouflaged as a refuge for the persecuted; the man who initiated and led American Jewry's assault on public opinion and political powers in order to win the support of the enlightened world for the just claims of the Jewish people, must be regarded as the greatest among Zionist leaders now alive.

It is not now the moment to inquire into the reasons of Rabbi Silver's withdrawal from the front ranks of Zionist life. We have done so on other occasions. This time we only join our voices to those of all Zionists of good will in giving expression to the hope that his sorely needed strength will soon be available to us again. Rabbi Silver has said that he will return if he is recalled. The plight of Israel and of the Jewish people demands that the call should not be delayed.

## Rokach Shuts 'Kol Ha'am' for 10 Days

JERUSALEM (INeS). — "Kol Ha'am," the Communist daily, was suspended for 10 days last week by order of the Minister of Interior, Mr. I. Rokach. He acted under the authority of the Palestine Press Ordinance.

In a letter to the editorial board of the paper, Mr. Rokach drew their attention to his previous warning that the paper's editorial on January 14 endangered public peace, and that, under article 19/1 of the Press Ordinance of 1933, he was empowered to suspend the paper if articles of such a nature continued to be printed.

"As in the January 23 issue of 'Kol Ha'am', a leaflet, under the title 'Israeli Cannon Fodder for Korea', was reprinted on the front page which contained false information liable, in my opinion, to cause alarm," Mr. Rokach continued, "and as in the January 26 issue of 'Kol Ha'am' there appeared an article on page two under the title 'Contemptible spies and murderers', which, in my opinion, endangers the public peace. I, the Minister of Interior, order, by authority of article 19/2 of the Press Ordinance, chapter 116 that the publication of 'Kol Ha'am' be suspended for a period of 10 days as from the date below (January 23)."

### 'American' Leaflet

The leaflet, which Mr. Rokach mentions in his letter, was alleged by "Kol Ha'am" to have been circulated by "American circles in Israel". It calls on ex-servicemen and all unemployed to volunteer to fight in Korea against the Communists, "otherwise we will die of starvation here".

The article entitled "Contemptible Spies and Murderers" was a reprint of the "Pravda" editorial dealing with the doctors' plot.

JERUSALEM (INeS). — We shall use all the legal measures at our disposal to put a stop to the vile and shameful

doctrine of hatred against Israel which is being surreptitiously spread in the States, declared the Minister of Defense, Mr. D. Ben Gurion, in reply to Mrs. E. Vilenski (Communist) in the Knesset, who asked why the Communist organ "Kol Ha'am" had ceased to be distributed among the troops. The Minister added that an organ which was openly supporting and spreading base and Nazi-like charges against Israel and the Jewish people would not be distributed among the forces at State expense.

## GA Newspaper Demands Clear Western Orientation

TEL-AVIV (INeS). — "Ha-Boer" (General Zionist daily) in a leading article last week, calls for a clear-cut Western orientation of Israel foreign policy, since, according to the paper, the fate morganatic neutrality, as well as hopes of social changes in the neighbouring Arab countries and of early peace with them, should by now have vanished. Commenting on events in Egypt, the paper asserts that once more it has been proved that Israel is the only reliable State in this part of the world, and that the West could send its jet planes directly to Moscow, instead of the Arab countries, because in case of war, these planes would easily fall into the hands of Russian airborne troops.

But in order to convince the West of Israel's usefulness, we should consolidate the State ideologically and economically, show diplomatic initiative and use the good services of the Zionist movement abroad.

## Dr. Sneh Expelled From Mapam

TEL-AVIV (INeS). — Dr. Sneh and his followers, who had justified the anti-Zionist and virulent anti-Jewish nature of the late Prague proceeding, have been expelled from the Mapam party. In consequence of this, Dr. Sneh's group have announced that they will in future constitute a left wing faction of Mapam in the Knesset.

municipal and suburban communications. As part of the new program, suburban transportation will have only seating space in its buses. Tel Aviv Celebration in Honor of Dr. Silver Recorded

NEW YORK (ZINS) - The National Office of the Zionist Organization of America has received a tape recording of the program of the celebration in honor of Dr. Abba Hillel Silver's 60th birthday, which was held in Tel Aviv on February 5th, sponsored by the General Zionist Party in ZOA House, the same day that the Zionist Organization of America celebrated the anniversary of the Zionist leader. The recording was sent as a gift to Dr. Silver.

The City Council of Ramat-Gan sent a parchment scroll which contains the greetings of Ramat-Gan to Dr. Silver on his 60th birthday.

Conference of ZOA Youth District in Atlantic City

NEW YORK (ZINS) - The role of Jewish Youth in the struggle of the Jewish people will be the main topic of a four-day conference of the Young Zionist Districts of the Zionist Organization of America, which will take place in Atlantic City this weekend. The 400 delegates from every part of the country, which will participate in the conference, will work out a plan for the mobilization of the General Zionist Youth in the United States. The main speakers at the Conference will be Louis Lipsky, Chairman of the American Zionist Council; Jacques Torczymer, Chairman of the ZOA Committee on World Zionist Affairs; Rabbi Amram Prero, Director of the American Zionist Youth Commission; and representatives of the Israel Consulate and Jewish Agency.

Export of 20-Million Eggs From Israel This Year

JERUSALEM (ZINS) - At a conference of the owners of poultry farms in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry headed by Dr. Bernstein (President of the General Zionist Party in Israel), plans were drawn up for the export of 20-million eggs from Israel during the coming winter. The Ministry of Commerce and Industry pledged its full support to the implementation of the program.

RIO DE JANEIRO, March 2. (JTA) -- Emulating the Moscow policy of purging Jews from high positions in the Communist Party, the Communist Party of Brazil has expelled from its ranks Maurice Grabois, who was secretary general of the party for many years. Grabois was a member of Congress and was considered one of the top Communist leaders in the country.

DR. SILVER HONORED IN MEXICO; ADDRESSES HUGE ZIONIST MEETING

MEXICO CITY, March 2. (JTA) -- Rabbi Abba Hillel Silver left Mexico today following a banquet given in his honor by the General Zionist Organization of Mexico. The affair was arranged in connection with the celebration of Dr. Silver's 60th birthday, and was held at Hotel Del Prado.

During his stay here, the American Zionist leader paid a visit to the Foreign Minister of Mexico and also visited a number of Jewish institution. He was the principal speaker last night at a huge meeting in the Mexico City Sport Center arranged by the General Zionist Council.

NEWARK WELFARE FEDERATION ELECTS FIRST JEW AS PRESIDENT

NEWARK, N. J., March 2. (JTA) -- Alan V. Loewenstein, Newark attorney and former president of the Jewish Community Council of Essex County, has been elected president of the Welfare Federation of Newark. He is the first Jew ever to be elected to the post.

Mr. Loewenstein has served as chairman of the legal committee of the Adoption Advisory Council set up to revise the child adoption laws of New Jersey and is a member of the faculty of the Rutgers University Law School.

AMERICAN FRIENDS OF HEBREW UNIVERSITY MOURN PROF. SUKENIK

NEW YORK, March 2. (JTA) -- A statement mourning the loss of Prof. Eliezer Sukenik, head of the Hebrew University Department of Jewish Archaeology and Keeper of the Museum of Jewish Antiquities of Jerusalem, who died this past week-end, was issued here today by Dr. George S. Wise, president of the American Friends of the Hebrew University.

Prof. Sukenik's achievements, Dr. Wise said, "added immeasurably to the world's store of knowledge of the origins of our civilisation. To all who knew him, as a beloved teacher and an inspired researcher, the news of his death has brought a sense of grievous loss."

DR. LEO KOPF, LEADING JEWISH COMPOSER-CONDUCTOR, DIES AT 64

NEW YORK, March 2. (JTA) -- Dr. Leo Kopf, leading Jewish composer and conductor, died here last night at the age of 64. A noted figure in the musical world in Germany, where he was musical director of the Berlin Jewish Community until 1939, Dr. Kopf fled the Nazis to London where he formed a choral society and a string orchestra. He came to the United States during the Second World War.

SIR ROBERT WALEY COHEN LEAVES ESTATE OF \$162,000 TO FAMILY

LONDON, March 2. (JTA) -- Sir Robert Waley Cohen, leading personality of the Anglo-Jewish world, who died last November at the age of 75, left an estate of 58,000 pounds (\$162,000), it was revealed here today when the will was published. The entire estate was bequeathed to members of his family.


