Dear Mr. Krohngold, I was pleased indeed to learn that your distinguished congregation plans to celebrated in such fitting manner the seventieth birthday of your very distinguished Rabbi, Dr. Abba Hillel Silver. And I am equally pleased to accept your kind invitation to become a member of the Natidnal Committee of Sponsors of this very happy occasion. I must say frankly that it is probably fitting that I should receive this invitation and also that I should accept it, since not only am I the only surviving member of the Faculty of the Hebrew Union College who taught Dr. Silver there when he was preparing for the Rabbinate, but also, and even more, since I am directly responsible for his becoming the Rabbi of your congregation. This story may interest you. Rabbi Moses J. Ories and I were very close friends. fact in those days, whenever I visited Cleveland, which was at least once each year, in order to lecture to the teachers of the religious schools of the two Referm congregations then in your city, I was always the house-guest of Rabbi and Mrs. Gries in their then new home out on the Lake front. When, in the fall of 1916, Rabbi Gries determined to retire from the active Rabbinate, he came to Cincinnati to discuss with me the question of who his successor should be. He felt that I was well qualified to make such recommendations, both because of my having taught the then young Rabbis during the preceding ten years of my connection with the Hebrew Union College and also because I had been the Secretary of the Central Conference of American Rabbis for eight of these years. I recommended only one man to him, viz. Rabbi Silver. Evidently Rabbi Gries was firmly impressed by what I told him of Rabbi Silver and of his high ability and rich promise, for he, in turn, recommended him to the Board of your congregation. Subsequently, at the biennial meeting of the Union of American Hebrew Congegations in Baltimore, in the spring of 1917, at the personal request of the President of your congregation, whom I knew personally and quite intimately, but whose name I can not now remember, I introduced Rabbi Silver to him. He, in turn, was very favorably impressed. Shortly thereafter Rabbi Silver was elected to serve your congregation as successor to Rabbi Griss. In the light of these considerations, and also very proud of the distinguished service of Dr. Silver as a Rabbi in Israel,
