My dear Mrs. Silver -

On my desk is a letter which I had written to you two weeks ago - to be enclosed in the copy of "Virginia Woolf". I was hesitant about sending it as I wasn't sure of your exact address and now it is meaningless - In that letter I told you that I felt like two different people - the "creed me" keeping all that junk, and the "real me" coming home and wondering

who bought it. But if I had any regrets about the trip at all, it is erased now.


