He was truly blessed to have left behind two able sons, who will continue to be a blessing to his memory and will add to Abba Hillel's contributions of a better world for all God's children.

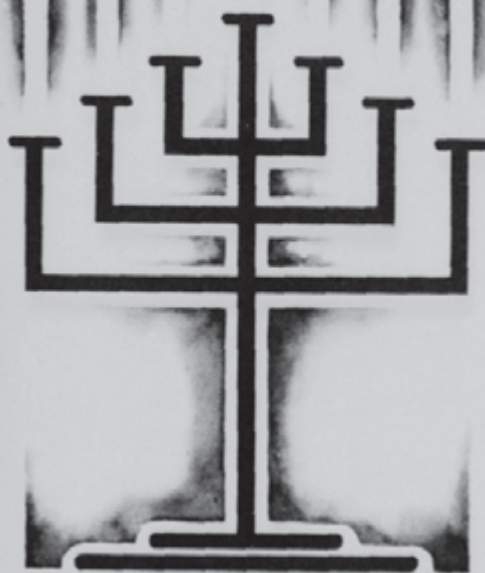
May your loving memories give you strength in these hours of mourning and may you emerge with renewed courage to carry on. We grieve with you.

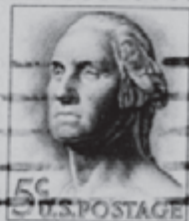

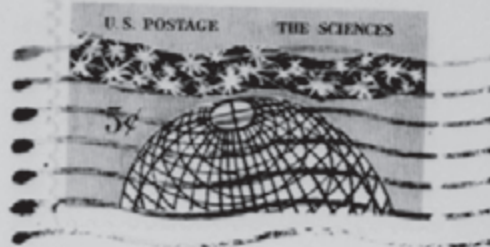


Dear Virginia,
