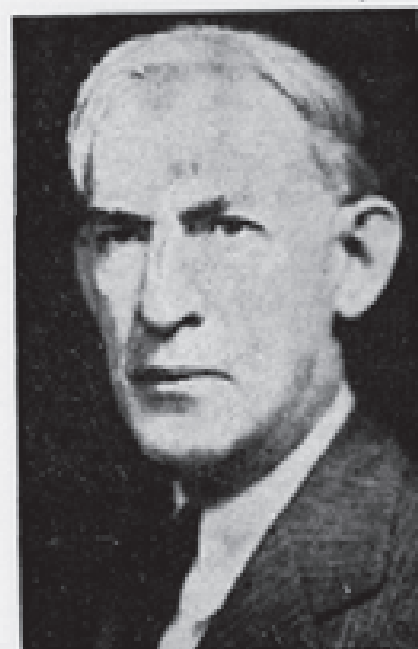
Abba Hillel Silver

This issue of *The Voice* is dedicated to Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, the President of the Zionist Organization of America and leader of the political activities of the Zionist movement in the United States. The symbol of the dedication is the Jewish National Fund. All who are participating intend therewith to demonstrate their respect for Dr. Silver and give expression to their deep appreciation of his valiant services in these critical days. Through the cooperative effort of a Dinner to be given to him on Sunday evening, March 31st, a fund is being gathered to establish on Jewish National Fund soil a Nachlah bearing his name.

The Bnai Zion, the Zionist fraternal organization, is the sponsor of the Dinner and of the National Fund effort, acting in cooperation with many Zionists of other groups. The chairman of the Sponsoring Committee is Mr. Daniel Frisch, with Dr. Harris J. Levine acting as associate chairman.



This tribute to Dr. Silver comes at an appropriate time. The spirit of Passover is in the air. It is the holiday of freedom. All the historic connotations of the Exodus and the entrance into the Promised Land are concentrated in the celebration of the Passover festival. The tribute to Dr. Silver is also a timely recognition of the exceptional quality of leadership which he has demonstrated in these critical days. It is a tribute to the fact that he has given pulse and direction with unusual force to the all-American support of Zionist political aspirations.

The time we live in is remarkable for its moral and intellectual confusion, for its lack of will to achieve just decisions and its disregard of all codes of ethical behavior. The vigorous attack on injustice inspired and led in the United States by Dr. Silver has enabled us to plow through great difficulties and to maintain Jewish morale and Jewish honor at a time when these qualities were most needed as defense of the Jewish position. So far as the United States is concerned, it may be claimed that through the efforts led by Dr. Silver, America is more keenly aware of the Jewish problem and more sympathetic than at any time in the history of the Jewish community in the United States. This vigorous attack on a world reluctant to face the demands of justice has given the Jewish people strength to endure the uncertainties and the tragic disappointments of the so-called post-war days. The diplomatic or practical methods of the past era have become empty of meaning and value. The rigid protocol breaks in the face of the terrible realities the world is called upon to grapple with. It would be tragic folly for Jews to adhere to standards—which have been abandoned in fact by the new world now being created.

The man to whom this tribute is given was the first effectively to give vent to an irrepressible desire to disregard the old method and old approach. He is the first effectively to fight with relentlessness and obstinacy for the practice of new methods of pressure. Through him, American Zionism was brought out into the open; it was induced to appear on the street, in the press, in the councils of labor unions, in the vestry rooms of churches and to agitate in the root sources of political power for vindication of the Zionist ideal. Through his remarkable persistence, and audacious defiance of conventions, it was possible to have the Legislative branch of our American Government override its Executive and to proclaim to the world its unequivocal support of our cause. Thus, Zionism became the American policy through struggle and not through benevolent acquiescence.

Our tribute to Dr. Silver is a tribute to a man who came to his Zionist position out of an indubitable Zionist movement. His Zionism began in his earliest years. It began in his home, in the Cheder, in the books he read, in the friends he had. He was born that way and what he was born with was built upon from what he learned from his father and his father's example. His Jewish life was interwoven with a Zionism based on the Hebraic renaissance, which has given substance and color to his oratory and natural pride to his political endeavors.

It is fortunate that the American Zionist movement has had Dr. Silver as its advocate and spokesman in these days of trial and struggle. A greater work on a larger field lies before him, which, we hope, he will have the strength and the wisdom to pursue with matured purpose.

Hut Ha-Meshulash

LIFE often weaves upon its shuttle, out of silken threads, strong cords which achieve the ultimate in indivisibility. Great friendships, abiding loves fused into a oneness by their spiritual affinity give abundant testimony to the validity of this truth.

When approached by the leaders of the Order Bnai Zion to assume the chairmanship of the Nahlath Silver undertaking, I was prompted to accept readily by the contemplation that the order, the Jewish National Fund and Dr. Silver, are three silken threads woven into one stout cord symbolic of the strength of our cause.

The Order Bnai Zion, although comparatively small in number, embodies in its constituency—perhaps more than any other group within the Zionist organization of America—the folk aspect of our movement. As I came closer to the Order, it was a revelation to discover the almost fanatical devotion of its rank and file to the Z. O. A., its parent organization and to the Jewish National Fund, the most popular agency within the framework of Zionism. Reflecting its constituency the Order's leadership is largely selfless and unassuming. What is more, a careful observer cannot escape the feeling that the Order Bnai Zion is yet at the threshold of new and widening vistas of service and growth.

The Keren Kayemeth L'Israel always moves me to the depths. Its romance, its scope, its vision, its mind-shaking goals, its epic story, pale everything possible superlative. It is tangent to the sensitive soul of every Zionist. In these days, when it is becoming increasingly fashionable amongst some Zionists to countenance the shunting of the J. N. F. to a place of secondary importance, the Order has taken the Fund to its bosom. It was therefore a feat of genius for Bnai Zion to have wedded its Order Day to the Jewish National Fund and to have made its annual affair a medium for raising substantial amounts for the coffers of the Fund.

Over two decades of public life have taught me well the dangers that lurk for one who speaks with unpolished candor about powerful personalities who lead men. Criticism seems to evoke in many the suspicion of pre-judg-



ment. Praise is too frequently misconstrued as a bid for more recognition. Nevertheless, with regard to Dr. Silver there seems to be overwhelming agreement that he represents amazingly and matchlessly the unique type of leadership needed to mold Jewish destiny. It was my good fortune to have had the opportunity to monopolize countless hours of Dr. Silver's time in our endless walks on the streets of London while we were both attending the London Zionist Conference. I was able, then, to look into his soul. He stubbornly refuses to compromise. He believes that one cannot be a Zionist unless his soul is emptied of the slavery that many a Jew acquires in freedom. He is the voice of our people's grief and the harp of our hopes. As I write these lines, I feel that Dr. Silver, like the Order and the Jewish National Fund, is only at the beginning of his unfolding genius. The immediate future is pregnant with destiny for him.

The Bnai Zion, the Keren Kayemeth, and Dr. Abba Hillel Silver are a Hut Ha-Meshulash.

ZIONISTS ARE UNITED

IN DEDICATING this year's Order Day dinner to Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, we in Bnai Zion seek not only to honor a great leader, but to hold up the hands, to use a figure of speech, of a man who has been summoned at a critical hour, when the fate of

our movement is in the balance, to go forward and batter down the enemies who seek to turn the Balfour Declaration into a scrap of white paper.

For the first time since 1941, we gather at our annual function in a world allegedly at peace, but alas, we cannot say that peace has come to the Jew. At the very hour when we might justifiably have looked forward to the full fruition of our hopes, that government which first recognized our efforts, and that party which had always been most lavish in its sympathy to its cause, has betrayed its sacred pledges.

It is a happy omen that at this critical hour, Dr. Silver has been called to leadership by what amounts to virtual unanimity. We Jews have many good qualities, but the ability to act unanimously is not generally reckoned as

one of them. Yet it is significant that at this time, the leadership of Dr. Silver is acclaimed by all. It is a fine testimony, I think, not only to Dr. Silver, but to the sincerity of our Zionist convictions. Whatever differences we may have, whatever personalities we may permit ourselves to indulge in at this or that time, when a danger hour approaches, we fall in line as obedient and trained soldiers.

Dr. Silver's Zionism is not of today or yesterday. Its roots go deep. Springing up in childhood, it grew stronger with the years. As a leader in the rabbinate, he had carried the flag of Zionism in circles which at first might be regarded as the enemy's country. It is a signal testimony to the growth of Zionism and to Dr. Silver that today Dr. Silver is President of the Central Conference of American Rabbis, an organization which, not so very long ago, seemed the sacred preserves of those who, to say the least, were not of our sympathizers.

Dr. Silver brings to his post a fine Hebrew scholarship, a fit ornament for Zionist leadership and a fine mainspring for intellectual inspiration to our movement. He is endowed with a rare eloquence to move the hearts and minds of men—to enable them to see the vision of Judea reestablished with all the beauty he sees it himself. He is a religious seer united with a statesman and fortified by a valiance so necessary in these troublous days for Jewry and the world.

The Making of a Leader

AT THIS time when Bnai Zion is nationally honoring Dr. Abba Hillel Silver at its special "Order Day" exercises, it may not be amiss to turn back the pages of time. The child is father to the man, say the old adage. Certainly the career of Abba Hillel Silver bears this out.

It was at the death of Theodore Herzl that Abba Hillel Silver, then ten years old, first threw himself into the Zionist movement.

If it was given to Herzl to witness from some Heavenly point the mourning of his people at his passing in 1904, he could have been pleased with nothing so much as the way the Silver boys reacted.

The Jews of the world were bowed in grief, which they vented in meetings, eulogies, the recital of the Kaddish for the dead leader.

Young Abba Hillel Silver and his brother, Maxwell vented their grief in a constructive action, designed to carry on the work of Herzl. They addressed themselves to their school mates at the Voloshiner Yeshiva on the East Side and formed the Dr. Herzl Zion Club.

It was the first Zionist youth organization established in the United States. It was in the course of the establishment of this club that Abba Hillel Silver first learned that Zionism was not only a vision and a philosophy but a battle. Our minds do not have to travel far back to remember when Abba Hillel Silver began to take up the cudgels for Zionism among his colleagues of the Reform rabbinate, but it is often forgotten that in the early days of the movement, pious orthodox Jews fought it as strenuously. The authorities at the Yeshiva on the East Side where the Silver boys studied would have nothing of this Zionism, which seemed to them to affront their doctrine that the Messiah would come, bringing deliverance to Jews, riding on a little white pony, in God's good time. It was a considerable time before some in the fold of traditional Judaism could get that little white pony out of their minds. Perhaps the coming of the automobile hastened the process of elimination. We remember that even in Palestine it has not been very long since some of the Jews objected to the speaking of Hebrew as the language of workaday world, holding that it was to be reserved for the synagogue.

It happened that the two Silver boys had in their father, Reb Moshe Silver, a man who came to their side so strongly that they were able to preserve their organization. Reb Moshe Silver was a teacher at the Machsikei Talmud Torah, a staunch Zionist and a man of considerable scholarly attainments. An elderly man now living in Palestine, a few years back Reb Moshe Silver composed a commentary on one of the books of the Bible which was highly praised by discerning critics.

Reb Moshe Silver encouraged his young sons and the two Silver boys reorganized the liquidated organization. Maxwell Silver was the first president of the organization and a year later, Abba Hillel was elected president. The

selection of one member of the family to follow the other cannot be attributed to any juvenile nepotism. It was simply that both of the boys had been the principal activators of the society and both possessed qualities of leadership. To say this is to pay them a high tribute indeed, for the club included many boys who as men have come to occupy very important positions in the Jewish and general world. Among the boys were Emanuel Neumann, the present Vice-President of the Zionist Organization, Sol Cohen, long an active figure in the Zionist movement, George Sokolsky, the well known columnist of the *New York Sun*, Rabbi Barnett Brickner of Cleveland, Eleizer Sheinmark, who as Brent Mark was at one time editor of a New York daily newspaper, Rabbi Jesse Schwartz, a leading figure in the Zionist movement in Canada, David W. Pearlman, Rabbi in Stamford, the Jewish educator, Israel Chipkin, Dr. Reuben J. Holland, prominent New Jersey physician, Reuben Grossman who has been acclaimed as the first American born Hebrew author and poet.

It was plainly an all-star boys club. It would seem that many communities would have welcomed such an aggregation. But then these boys were Zionists, and if the pious Orthodox did not want them, the pious Reformed Jews didn't think them kosher either. Dr. David Blaustein, the superintendent of the Educational Alliance, a staunch Zionist, who was chosen as the first Nassi of the Order Bnai Zion, had true enough, allowed them to meet in the Educational Alliance. But then Dr. Blaustein had been succeeded by Dr. Henry W. Fleischman, and one day Dr. Fleischman, accompanied by Julia Richman (the Julia Richman High School in New York is named after her) came into the room in which the Herzl Club was meeting and to their consternation found the members speaking in Hebrew. Dr. Fleischman could not have been more flabbergasted if he had found the boys playing dice. Dr. Fleischman and Miss Richman gave the boys a lecture on Americanism and warned them that speaking Hebrew was taboo. Dr. Fleischman of course did not know that in early America, Harvard University had insisted that every student learn Hebrew and that after the American Revolution, as H. L. Mencken has pointed out, a number of Americans suggested that Americans adopt Hebrew as the national language.

Anyway, the British Labor Government should have its way as much as Dr. Fleischman had! Sol Cohen still recalls how Abba Hillel Silver rose and calmly told Dr. Fleischman that the Herzl Club in harmony with the ideals of the movement would continue to employ the language which David had found suitable for his psalms and Isaiah fit to vision his dreams of universal brotherhood.

The Dr. Herzl Zion Club continued to meet at the Educational Alliance, but their troubles were not over. Abba-

ham Goldfadden, the famous Yiddish and Hebrew playwright became interested in the boys group and wrote a play in Hebrew especially for the Club. The name of the play was "David ha-Milchama"—David at War.

Again the authorities at the Educational Alliance blocked the way. Their auditorium would not be used for the performance of a play in Hebrew, they proclaimed. The members of the Club got together and Sol Cohen was deputized to see Jacob Sapirstein, the publisher of the *Jewish Morning Journal*. Sapirstein got in touch with the Educational Alliance and warned them that if they prohibited the Herzl Club from using their auditorium, the next morning there would appear an editorial in the paper giving the Educational Alliance Hail Columbia.

The Educational Alliance bowed to the inevitable. But there were still troubles ahead. The play was in Hebrew, the number of Jews who could understand Hebrew was even then not too large—yet audiences must be gathered. It was Abba Hillel Silver who solved the problem.

Silver was deputized to visit the various landsmanschaften and Jewish organizations to sell tickets. Selling them tickets for a play in Hebrew was not too easy a thing. Young Abba Hillel had recourse to a Tom Sawyer device. Rising to make an appeal for the buying of tickets, Abba, as Sol Cohen chucklingly recalls, would concentrate on one individual in his audience. "You," he would say, pointing his finger at this selected individual, "understand the importance of promoting Hebrew culture. You are a man of culture yourself, you see the significance of developing the Hebrew drama," and so on and so on.

The man so flattered by young Abba had no alternative. Inevitably, he rose after the conclusion of the speech and made a motion that the Landsmanschaft buy so many tickets.

The Dr. Herzl Club grew. In time it had branches in Harlem and New Jersey. It was the first youth group to send a delegate to the American Federation of Zionists

convention. That delegate was Abba Hillel Silver, who addressed the convention in 1907 in Hebrew, making a profound impression. Out of the Dr. Herzl Club grew the Young Judea Organization.

Entering Hebrew Union College, where at the time Dr. Kaufman Kohler was President and Zionism was more "trefa" than pork, Abba Hillel Silver nevertheless continued unflinchingly to stand by Zionism.

Graduating from the Hebrew union, Silver's first rabbinical position was at Wheeling, West Virginia. From there, he was called to Cleveland, Ohio. His predecessor at Cleveland had been vehemently anti-Zionist and there was some alarm expressed when the authorities at the Temple found they had given a contract to a Zionist rabbi. Dr. Silver however offered to release them from their contract if they desired. They did not desire.

Dr. Silver found that the Temple in other ways was not as Jewish as he wished. There was no Shefer Torah in the Temple. Silver demanded that a Torah be installed. He insisted also that there be Saturday services. Formerly there had been only a Sunday morning service.

Today the ideas of Dr. Silver are not so uncommon among even members of the Reform rabbinate. The very fact that Silver is today the President of the Central Conference of American Rabbis in itself attests to this fact. And we owe this fact—this condition—in some degree at any rate to the courageous battle of Silver.

I have referred to the early opposition to Zionism on the part of some Jews who felt that it was in conflict with the messianic ideas of Judaism. Yet of course in the more fundamental sense, Zionism is of the very essence of this messianism. It simply insists that this redemption for which the Messiah-lookers hoped for, can only come if we direct our efforts toward it. Joshua in ancient times had to battle for the Promised Land. In different ways, we have to battle for it today. It is very interesting to note that perhaps the best book extant on the topic of the Messianic idea was written by Abba Hillel Silver.

I am glad to have you call my attention to this deserved honor to be conferred upon Dr. Silver. As you know, I have been able to observe his sincerity, honesty, and loyalty to the cause. Since I cannot be present in person, I am glad to join those who honor him in person and in spirit on this occasion.

This world is undergoing a great trial in many ways at this time. The war has left its aftermath of chaotic suspicion and misunderstanding. I have faith to believe that it will all finally pass away and that justice and equality will settle down upon the people of the world, but it will require patience and long suffering and the cooperation of all to bring this about. Dr. Silver has these qualities and is able to impart them to others, and I am happy to join in wishing for him and the cause which he so ably represents continued good wishes and success.

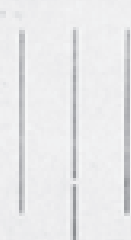

Bnai Zion holds the enviable record of having made the largest per capita contribution to the land redemption program of the Jewish National Fund in this country.

This dedication to Zionist fundamentals is epitomized by the purpose to which the observance of Bnai Zion Order Day is annually devoted—the redemption of Eretz Israel's soil as the national and inalienable property of the Jewish people.

The forthcoming observance of Order Day should evoke even greater interest and cooperation. Tendered in honor of Dr. Abba Hillel Silver, President of the Zionist Organization of America and Co-Chairman of the American Zionist Emergency Council, to whom Zionists of all shades of opinion are eager to pay tribute, Bnai Zion has thus dedicated the Order Day in tribute to a leader whose rare gifts and distinguished service to the cause are widely acknowledged and appreciated by the acquisition of a land tract which will bear the name **NACHLATH SILVER**.

Another area of Eretz Israel's soil will in this manner be reclaimed and made the foundation for a new thriving agricultural settlement which is to serve as haven and home for survivors of Nazi barbarism still languishing in "liberated" Europe; a center of new life for men and women who look to Palestine as their chief hope to piece together there the broken threads of their bruised lives.

And there is more than the obvious humane significance to this enterprise at this time. When the British Army is attempting—as has happened recently in Birya, Upper Galilee—to prevent by force the creation of new outposts of civilization on the waste-lands of Palestine, land redemption programs like Nachlath Silver symbolize the very essence of our present struggle. The happy conclusion of the Birya incident, in which right triumphed over might, is an earnest of the quality of our resistance which will inevitably lead to the fulfillment of Jewish aspirations in Palestine.

The controversy over the issue of free Jewish immigration to the Jewish National Home, frequently highlighted by the landing on the shores of Eretz Israel of

Jewish survivors without the benefit of British certificates, is a widely known epic. Less spectacular, but equally vital, is the battle which is being waged by the Jewish National Fund on Palestine's land front. This instrumentality which was fashioned in the early days of the Zionist movement as a unique experiment in national land ownership based upon the principles of social justice and cooperative effort, is today one of the mighty weapons of Zionist achievement.

The potency of the Jewish National Fund has been effectively demonstrated in the vigorous resistance it was called upon to offer since February, 1940 when the Palestine Government promulgated its infamous Land Edict as the second phase of the cruel and strangulating policy of the Chamberlain-McDonald White Paper. This Land Edict has had the avowed aim of barring the largest part of the mandated territory to Jewish settlement.

How effective this struggle has been is eloquently evidenced by the record of the Jewish National Fund's land acquisitions in all parts of the country during the war years, notwithstanding the paralyzing provisions of the Land Transfer Regulations. In the teeth of severe government opposition and against the obstacles of a rising market, the Keren Kayemeth has succeeded in almost doubling its land possessions during these years. These new areas, together with the tracts acquired by the Jewish National Fund before the outbreak of World War II, created the foundation upon which close to fifty new settlements have been founded. Truly, this is a record which borders on the heroic.

The recent National Keren Kayemeth Conference at Pittsburgh envisaged an immediate land purchase program of 500,000 dunams which can be realized even under existing restrictions. In addition, there has been adopted a long range program aiming at the redemption of areas comprising 2,000,000 dunams over a period of years with the lifting of the present land restrictions. Thus the present needs will be met and Jewish land possessions will be doubled and trebled in the foreseeable years ahead.

The linking of the name of Dr. Abba Hillel Silver with the implementation of this vital program of land acquisition through Nachlath Silver is a symbol of our continuing resistance to British policy and a bond of our solidarity with the Yishuv today and tomorrow.

Nachlath Silver will be a tangible expression not only of the high esteem in which the President of the Zionist Organization of America is held by Zionists throughout the land. It will be another link in the golden chain of Jewish continuity and Jewish creative life in Palestine.

A Tribute to Dr. Abba Hillel Silver

I AM deeply appreciative of the thoughtfulness of the "Order Bnai Zion" in granting me the opportunity of joining them on the occasion of the 38th Annual Order Day Banquet in paying tribute to a great leader, Dr. Abba Hillel Silver—The President of the Zionist Organization of America and the guest of honor.

It was my privilege, by virtue of my deep concern in the cause of the Jewish people and Palestine, to come intimately in contact with Dr. Silver, and I have learned to admire him as a friend, as a man of sterling qualities, as a great American, as a valiant warrior for the rights of his people, as a champion for the reconstitution of the Jewish national life in Palestine and as the brave exponent of the establishment there of a Free and Democratic Jewish Commonwealth.

The problem of Jewish homelessness today is and should be the problem of humanity; it is, indeed, an international problem.

On many an occasion I have given expression to my adherence to the ideals and aspirations of Zionism, and have joined those who were endeavoring to find a solution to the tragic homelessness of the Jewish people through the opening of the gates of Palestine—The Jewish National Home—to all the survivors of the concentration camps where they would rebuild their broken lives and regain their self-respect and human dignity.

The adoption of the recent Palestine Resolution during this session of the Congress indeed was no accident; it is expressive of the views and sentiment of all men of decency and good will. The eloquent voice of Dr. Silver in pleading the cause of Palestine and the Jewish people is indeed the voice of justice, freedom and decency. His

voice is compelling and irresistible. Humanity must listen, act and act speedily.

It is regrettable to state that there is today at least one people who are conscious that the war is not yet won: that people are the Jewish people who are being driven all over Europe today from pillar to post against a background of a cemetery of six million Jewish graves—the victims of the Nazis. In the land which was promised to them as the Jewish National Home, they are being cruelly haunted on land, on sea and in the air in order to prevent these tragic victims of Jewish Homelessness from entering Palestine. This is done in violation of the laws of men and God and it is based on no other force or justification except that of the power of the tiger jumping on its prey.

I like to believe that the nations of the world in the interest of humanity will remove the barriers at the gates of Palestine and grant to the homeless Jews of Europe full freedom of opportunity to return to the land of their forefathers and who will join their brethren there in the work of rebuilding Jewish life. It will be a creative life and a blessing to all the inhabitants of Palestine, regardless of race, color or creed.

Thus an end will come to the tragedy of Jewish Homelessness.

Let me assure you that I shall continue to raise my voice on behalf of the cause which is so nobly represented by the guest of honor, Dr. Abba Hillel Silver—the great tribune of the Jewish people—and will do everything in my power to help in hastening the day when your ideals and aspirations will be completely fulfilled.

May God grant Dr. Silver the privilege of celebrating that great day of triumph in the Land of Israel—IN A FREE DEMOCRATIC JEWISH COMMONWEALTH.
