WHEREAS the burdens imposed on the new democratic State of Israel resulted in dire shortages of essential food and other necessities, and


WHEREAS Israel's people are fighting to keep their country open to the thousands of displaced persons seeking a haven there,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, William O'Dwyer, Mayor of the City of New York, do hereby proclaim the week of February 20th through February 26th as


FOOD FOR ISRAEL WEEK

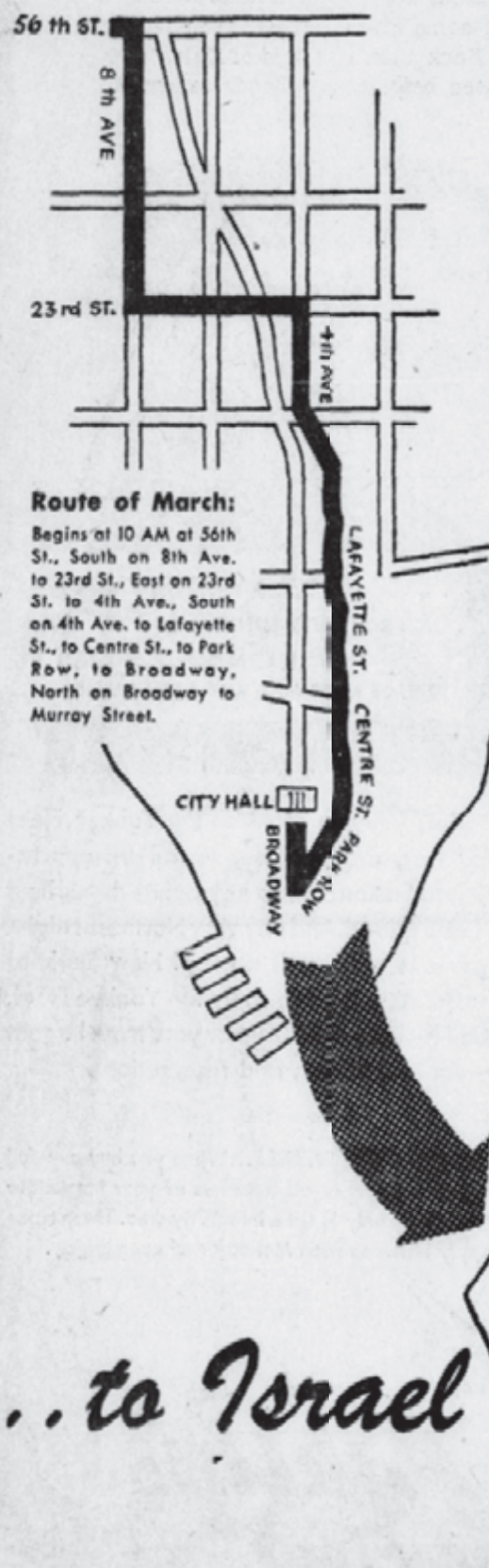

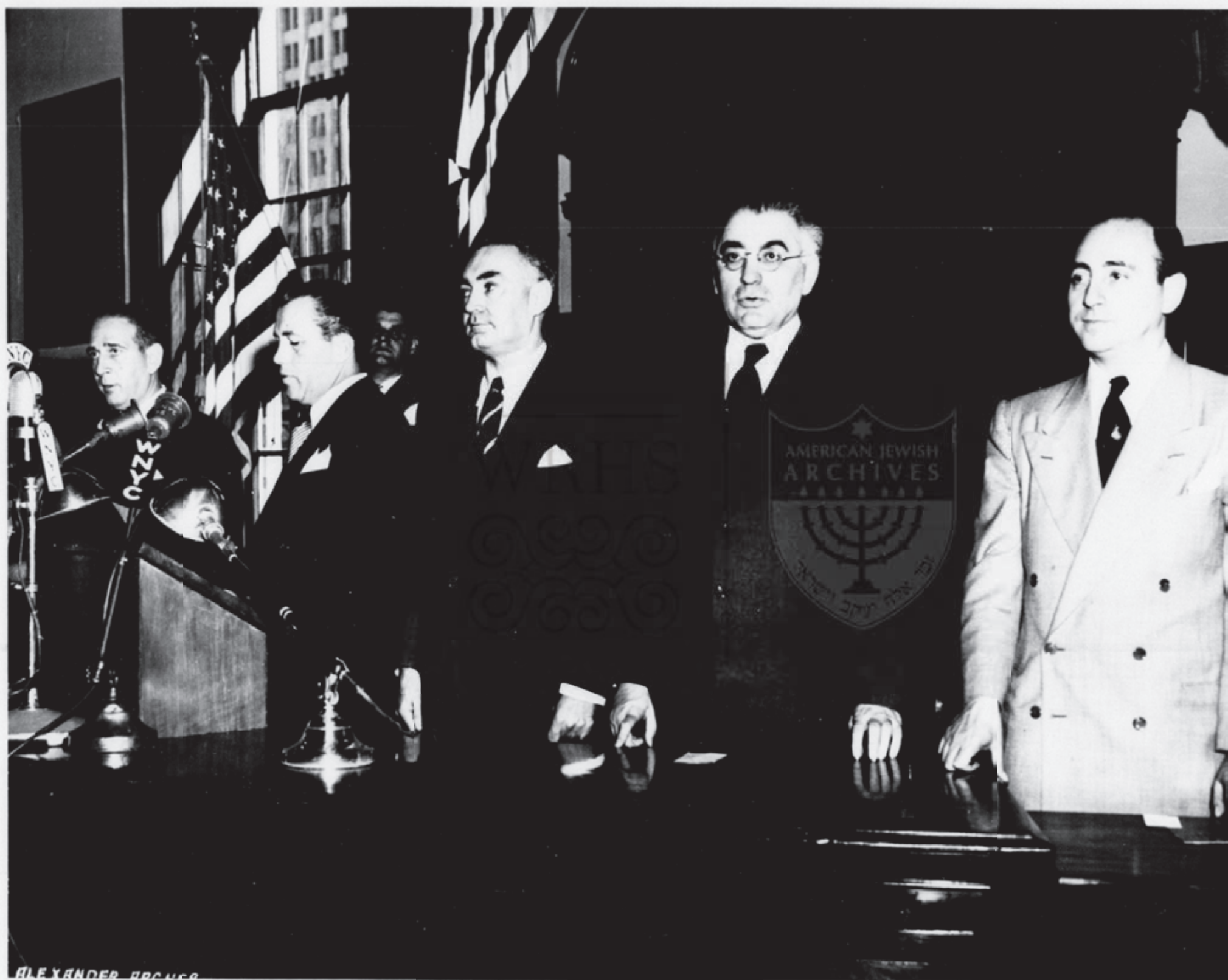
