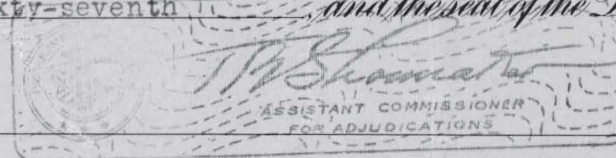

having applied to the Commissioner of Immigration and Naturalization for a certificate of derivative citizenship pursuant to Section 339 of the Nationality Act of 1940, having proved to the satisfaction of the commissioner that (s) he is now in the United States of America and is a citizen thereof through the naturalization of his father, Moses Silver, on July 13, 1906, by the United States District Court, at Brooklyn, New York, applicant being then a minor and having resided permanently in the United States since June 5, 1902,
