ABSTRACTS FROM PASSPORT REGULATIONS

1. Passports are issued in the United States by the Secretary of State, through the Passport Division, Department of State, Washington, D. C. Applications for passports should be made in person to clerks of Federal courts, clerks of State courts having jurisdiction in naturalization matters, or to passport agents of the Department of State. Passport agents of the Department of State are stationed at New York, Boston, New Orleans, Chicago, San Francisco, Seattle, and the Department of State, Washington, D. C. Applications should be filed from two to four weeks before the passport is required, depending upon the distance from Washington.

2. Americans residing or sojourning abroad should apply for passports through the nearest American consulate.

3. Applications for passports by persons in the Virgin Islands, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, or the Philippines, should be made to the chief executives of those islands.

4. Under the provisions of the Act of May 16, 1932, American passports are valid for two years from the date of issue unless limited to a shorter period. Such passports may be renewed under regulations prescribed by the Secretary of State for a period not to exceed two years but the final date of expiration shall not be more than four years from the original date of issue.

5. The fee for a passport, including \$1.00 for the execution of the application and \$9.00 for the passport, is \$10.00. The fee for the renewal of a passport is \$5.00.

6. The regulations provide that when the presumption of having ceased to be an American citizen has arisen against a naturalized American citizen under Section 2 of the Act of March 2, 1907, because of protracted foreign residence, his passport shall not be renewed until he shall have submitted to the Department of State or to a diplomatic or consular officer of the United States, evidence showing that the reason for such foreign residence comes within the rules prescribed by the Secretary of State whereunder such presumption may be overcome.

7. Americans making their homes or residing for a prolonged period abroad should register at the nearest American consulate.

Important notice to passengers

Passengers who come to France to remain there some time must, immediately upon arrival in the city where they intend to make their principal sojourn, request at the Mayor's Office or at the Commissariat of Police, a "Carte d'Identité", and present two of their photographs in making this request.

They must not travel at all in the interior (from their place of sojourn) until after having had their "Carte d'identité" (French identity papers) vised by the Mayor or the Commissaire of Police.

If they leave France for a neutral or allied country or to return to their country of origin they must have their passport vised by the Préfet of the Department of their place of sojourn (at Paris Préfecture of Police), and in case of return to the United States, by the American Consul having (original) jurisdiction.

If, having left France for an allied or neutral country, they return to France, they must have their passport vised by the French Consul having jurisdiction.

Foreigners coming from these countries (i.e. neutral countries) and crossing France en route to the United States obtain, besides the visa of the French Consul, the visa of the American Consul of the same (original) jurisdiction. The formalities of the visa by the Préfecture, Commissariats and consulates, requiring a certain time, the interested (persons) should make their request (for visa) several days in advance if for the United States, two weeks in advance.

They are absolutely obligatory, and if not executed, will cause the formal refusal to leave or to re-enter or the refusal to embark at the port, according to the circumstances.

Frenchmen going to foreign countries are subject to the same visa requirements at each voyage. The visa for the embarkation is not given until after the reglementary visas above-mentioned. Passengers will call at the Commissariat Special of the port, the day of the embarkation, or the day before at the earliest.
