

Rabbi Abba Hillel Silven

July 19, 1948

We view with a feeling of deep pride the note that has been taken of the great service our distinguished spiritual leader has rendered to humanity When our century was inits teens a young man came to our community to become the spiritual leader of our congregation. He had been chosen to succeed the late Pabli Moses Gries. Here was an assignment with challenge, freighted with opportunity for service, pointed up by the critical moment in national and world affairs.

Gifted with learning, breadth of interest and magnificent expression, the new young Rabbi soon demonstrated his abilities and vigor not only within the immediate scope of his official capacity, but likewise in the broader communities of his city and nation.

The fire of his oratory expressing the discernment and evaluation of conditions and circumstances which compelled his words, had the quality of that unusual blend of leadership, understanding and devotion which has marked his activities throughout the thirty-one years he has lived and worked among sus.
