

Lots of people live only a state or so away from their children or grandchildren. We live half way 'round the world from our family, so we plan each year's program with that fact in mind.

Thus the end of May found us on our way to New Zealand for a month of lazy sightseeing and a bit of summer skiing with Rick and his parents. The lovely South Island small city of Queenstown was our principal base; but we toured North Island as well, to meet the Maoris and to enjoy the geysers and miles of superb sea coast there. Then another month together in Indonesia, in the "kids'" lovely home there. We helped Firdaus' parents celebrate their 50th anniversary along with their 9 children, 21 grandchildren, and 1st great-grandchild--quite a party. (Doris was an only child until she joined that clan!)

Apart from this lively South Pacific interlude 1989 found us mostly at home in Prescott, or out exploring nearby corners of Arizona, Utah and Colorado. We have many nice friends here; we are also getting acquainted gradually with earlier neighbors--the Anasazi culture, the "ancient ones" of Indian lore. Cactus, ponderosa pines, javelinas, deer and the odd tarantula and black widow spider are among other new friends. So our snapshot catches the Southwestern flavor which is beginning to get into our blood.

As a member of the Prescott Docents group, affiliated with Phoenix Art Museum, Anita enjoys helping 2nd graders look at art in new ways. Award of the Nobel Peace Prize to our old friend the Dalai Lama has finally inspired Walter to do a bit of writing instead of just talking about it. The theme: inter-faith dialogue as a personal experience, not only an academic or institutional activity. And of course we both continue to be actively engaged in our church affairs.

Our young Tibetan friend Tashi and two other talented artists are now established in San Francisco as the Tibetan Dance Company, presenting performances in university and other community settings. If you are interested, we will be glad to provide details.

Many of you have, like us, been substantially involved in European affairs since World War II. So recent developments in eastern Europe pack a special wallop for some of us, don't they? In our Geneva days "Peace with Justice" were the carefully balanced goals which the churches and others tried to hold in perspective. Not a bad prayer theme to keep in mind when we consider the many problematical situations, old and new, around the world.

And may 1990 bring each of us our own share of peace.

It's taken too long for me to be able to put into words how much your presence and counseling meant to me during my darkest days. Though I was semiconscious after being hospitalized, I vividly remember awakening to see you sitting beside my bed. My closest friends and family couldn't bear to visit me in that state, and knowing that you were there made me feel so much less alone.

Sometimes I think that your illness affected your eyes first because you had seen just too much pain. Throughout your illness, you have been and continue to be a source of inspiration and a model of human dignity. I thank God that you have retained the "spark" within.

With a strong, renewed sense of well-being and self-esteem, I look forward to the year ahead. It will be a big one for us, including a summer trip to Europe (primarily the old family homeland of Hungary) and launching Nikki off to college. Then I will seek gainful employment so that I can continue to take responsibility for myself, which I have come to relish. Some of my friends think that I have adjusted all too well to this single lifestyle!

Dear Adele and Dan,

Whenever the 1300 miles that separate us seem too great a distance, we find ourselves very close indeed. Take last Sunday morning, for example.

I was in the waiting room of a hospital nearby. Shy was being examined in the emergency room as a follow-up to an accident on the tennis court. He fell on his arm and had 5 stitches taken to close a wound. Not too serious, but a definite disappointment to a little boy who just LOVES to go out to play!!

A worried couple came in and sat next to me. He hovered over the little woman and she, with a tremendous bandage on her thumb, looked ready to faint. She put her head between her knees and I asked if I could help. I touched her arm which was like ice!...."oh,"said she," you're SO warm". So, for the next 15 -or-so minutes, until she was called in to the emergency room, I kept up enough patter to distract her from that ominous-looking thumb.

She'd been slicing a bagel and sliced her thumb instead. They'd just moved in to a condominium from another Florida community....they were tired and nervous and without a friend. She told me that the last time they were at a hospital to get help for her, HE fainted. So we talked about anything and everything in an effort to keep both of them calm.

We exchanged enough vital statistics to learn that she lived for many years in Buffalo.....near where Sally and Bruce and the boys are now. Her father was a lifelong friend of Abba Hiklel Silver. He was Rabbi Marius Ranson.....revered by his congregation and the reform Jewish

community. It was he who coralled other rabbis and ministers and made it their business to approach hotels in Miami which catered to neither dogs nor Jews. Rabbi Ranson insisted that the managers remove such signs from the premises. The lady is Joan Ranson Tabor.....Florida's regional field consultant for Hadassah. We parted like lifelong friends, and she insists upon meeting Sally et al this week when they visit us!

So wherever we are, you are with us.

Our winter continues to be very pleasant. We can't possibly improve on the weather and our days and nights are filled with various fun things. Last Friday we attended services at Temple Beth El....it was the week of Mother's and Ruth's deaths.... saw several Clevelanders there, as usual. On Friday our two grandsons (Jordy, 9 and Spencer, 3) will go with us to the Ringling Barnum and Bailey Circus. 

Dear Rabbi Silver:

My husband, Jack M. Shepard, and I were members of The Temple for many years. You confirmed my daughter, Dana, in 1961. I remember reporting to you at The Temple eighteen years ago that Dana had chosen the name, Jeremy, for her "First Born" because she always liked "your" middle name (and the initial "J" honored her father who had died in 1952.)

I moved to Chicago three years ago due to the terminal illness (and subsequent death) of my second husband, Samuel S. Miller. Dana and I are members of Emanuel Congregation in Chicago. Rabbi Joseph A. Edelheit's Rosh Hashanah morning sermon quoted from your essay, "Can Judaism Survive the End of the Family?":

Rabbi Daniel Jeremy Silver, in a provocative essay, "Can Judaism Survive the End of the Family?" punctures the inflated-romanticized image of the Jewish family in later Jewish history. He notes: "The family unit for most of history, at least most of European history, was not a place of intimacy or warmth. It was an efficient place. It was a survival unit. It was an economic unit."

He correctly notes the completely separated worlds of men and women in which women were not equal to men in practical everyday matters and that women were often barely literate and experienced a great deal of detachment, not joy and fulfillment from a child, because of high infant mortality. These families lacked privacy, intimacy and security.

Rabbi Silver further notes that "traditional" families were shattered and became even more isolated as the industrial revolution and urbanization changed reality for everyone. The modern family adapted and was in a different form from what it always had been -- an economic and survival unit."

He concludes "Judaism existed and thrived for hundreds of years because of community rather than family. The traditional family was not a place of socialization, of feeling, or of emotion. It was the community which creates a Jewish identity, Jewish values, Jewish relationship."

Rabbi, I know that it is not unusual for you to be quoted, but in this instance it made us feel "at home".

## ► Rabbis dabble in the fine arts of faith

"Who is a rabbi? What is a rabbi? Why is a rabbi?" Daniel Jeremy Silver, a Cleveland rabbi, asks these questions. Chances are, unless you are a rabbi, you are ready to stop reading: why read a general newsletter with such a set of concerns? Yet, please read on. It's important for a culture to know something of the turns in a major profession. It's valid for non-Jews to understand, to do some comparing. I always think I know something, until someone asks. I know what a rabbi is. Then Silver asks. There are good questions and some answers.

Silver says that the first half of this century was the Golden Age of the American rabbinate because the pulpit was big in this "Protestantized milieu." Then the Protestant pulpit shrunk until "ministers who had spoken for an hour were succeeded by those who apologized when their talk ran over ten minutes." Few rabbis are measured by their pulpit work today. In "the post-World War II generation . . . rabbis downgraded their pulpit role." Nor is the synagogue itself necessarily the center of Jewish community life in the suburban era, when the Jewish federation "calls itself and is seen as *the* community." Rabbis' work has become circumscribed.

And diffused. Silver quotes conversations. "My therapist is a rabbi." "A rabbi was appointed Federation Director. . . ." "I needed a little-known halakic text. Fortunately, the librarian had rabbinic training." "Imagine, my stockbroker turns out to have been a rabbi. . . ." Sounds ministerial/priestly, doesn't it? People answered Silver's questions: a rabbi was a "teacher," "a preacher," "a leader in the community," "a spiritual adviser," "a Jewish clergyman." Those answers did not help much. How do rabbis see themselves? Romantically, says Silver, as "activist champions of a prophetic ethic, as key figures in the drama of Jewish survival, as respected interpreters of Torah, and as selfless servants of the Jewish people, if not mankind." Or they think of themselves as members of a learned profession ("but in real life, rabbis are more like high-school teachers than university faculty"). Silver: "Clergy are well liked but not necessarily listened to, and rabbis draw to themselves, deserved or not, some of those associations of mild generalism."

Silver reminds that many rabbis, like Christian clergy, find the clerical rabbinate fully satisfying. As clergy they are trained and hired to perform a specific set of services, meaningful if confining ones. But Silver notes that when congregations draw up qualifications for these folk who call their offices "studies," "no congregation has ever seriously listed 'scholar' as its primary requirement for a rabbinic appointment," and that changes things from European times. Today it's hard to know what is the source of rabbinic authority, since the claims for ordination are not "high" and "rabbis today explicitly reject the 'holy man' role of the Talmudic masters." It's hard to make it as a "religious figure" who represents the community.

Silver sees a need to reclaim some measure of rabbinic authority by having rabbis lead more than serve. "Rabbis deny that they are functionaries, but congregations draw up job descriptions for candidates, and, in fact, are encouraged to do so by the Placement Commission." Silver says he does best when he thinks of his work not as a profession but as an "art form." "My rabbinate becomes effective only as I focus on myself—my individuality, my talents, my hopes—and as I puzzle out how I can enhance Jewish life and honor my commitment to God and Torah." Each serious artist develops a personal style, and so should each rabbi. "A rabbi works with people, not paints," and accepts salary—which is a big

difference from the ways of the artistic world. In sum: "Our concern is not an absence of unanimity but the presence of rabbinic effectiveness. Great artists have their own specific vision. Picasso and Chagall accepted commissions but not direction. That is our challenge: to be paid to do congregational work and still be rabbis."

One of the respondents came to the issue of scholarship. Murray I. Rothman quoted David Polish: "It doesn't matter that in the rabbinate it is almost impossible to be a true scholar. What matters is that everyone can be a true student." Rothman thinks that the diffusion of roles is something rabbis will have to live with, and quotes Jeremy Silver's father, the great Rabbi Hillel Silver: "A rabbi . . . will, I believe, best fulfill his mission if he will set about to discover just what the predominant need of his age is, in the realm which he has made his own, and upon such findings, determine what the predominant occupation of his leadership will be."

Rabbi Jeffrey B. Stiffman is a bit disappointed in the fact that "this great rabbi" can find so many problems with the rabbinate. The St. Louisan says that Silver's article goes wrong because it's too me-defined. "I find missing a sense of *ahava*, of love. I read of love of oneself. Yet, I find very little said about the love of the rabbi's family, the need of a family and home that should be a part of the 'exemplary life' that Silver says we should lead." Or of love of congregant, of congregational leadership. Of our colleagues. So Stiffman chooses his art form: choreography. "We lead, we create, yet we are limited by the abilities of our members, just as a choreographer is limited by the abilities of particular dancers." Rabbinate will succeed in the contexts of members' limitations and possibilities.

And I think the discussion has been an artful choreographing of issues for us non-rabbis and the non-religious professionals or not-professionally religious. Many of the right issues get posed when believers look at each other in action. With *ahava*. (*Journal of Reform Judaism*)

### ► The church, the whole church, and nothing but the church

I've been reading Alan Peshkin's *God's Choice: The Total World of a Fundamentalist Christian School* (University of Chicago, \$24.95), and recommend it to anyone who thinks that the "total world" of such schools commends them as models for people who live in the sprawl of a pluralistic society. Peshkin spent 18 months studying a place he calls "Bethany Baptist Academy" in Illinois (after having done good preparatory work in South Asia and West Africa). Carol Flake, who reviews the book, says: "For Peshkin, a scholar and a Jew, immersion among fundamentalists was to become as far removed from home as his work among alien tribes." He tried hard to become a part of that world and came to understand some of its features.

Peshkin stresses the "contract" that makes Bethany a "total" institute like prisons and mental hospitals. Flake: "Peshkin found a certain amount of 'deviance' among students, including kids who continued to listen to rock music. . . . Secular culture . . . managed to intrude into the daydreams as well as the after-school activities of even the most angelic Bethany students." To his surprise he found these weren't brain-washed automatons, and that they could be models to public students in some respects. It's a fair-minded book. But "the real cost to Bethany students of denying the 'artistic, literary, social, and religious riches' of a pluralistic society, he says, is in 'what they do not become, what they cannot enjoy, what they fail to comprehend.' "

To me one of the most vivid pages had to do with the teachers' personal activities. A few read *Reader's Digest* or *Good Housekeeping* and watch "Little House on the Prairie," John Wayne movies, or, sneakily, "Dallas." But—except for their having been cajoled by the pastor into the Republican Party—they don't "belong" to anything but that one total institution. A statistic started a sentence: "Only one Bethany teacher belonged to any organization other than Bethany Baptist Church: the Christian Women's Club. She explains that . . . Bethany does not 'look kindly on it' " (p. 71). I have just decided to place my bets and risk my faith in a pluralistic society, letting the romantics have the "total" world. It's a nice place to visit, but I wouldn't want to live there. (*Washington Post Weekly*)
