



Dear Dan:

First of all, I was sorry to hear of the death of your mother, aleha ha'shalom. Please know that many of us are thinking of you and are saddened by your loss. No one knows better than we rabbis that words are, on the one hand, inadequate to the time and yet, on the other hand, reflect a caring despite their inadequacy.

I had intended to write you when I saw of the passing of your mother, but I was moved also to write to you after just reading your paper on the American Jewish situation and particularly that of Reform Judaism in your Temple bulletin. It is so very much on target! I have been feeling much of what you wrote and, in less eloquent and analytical terms, have shared it with my congregation. It seems, that institutional ritual has, in many places, replaced the old "social action/prophetic Judaism" commitment, but we have yet to touch the inner needs and motivations. I believe it is ironic, too, that it is the rise of the Christian Right which, at least in my part of the country, makes me more and more aware of our defect. We are quick to criticize or even ridicule them, yet the needs they address if not the answers they give are common to everyone.

I will look forward eagerly to seeing some of the answers you offer in future bulletins and in any parts of the program life of your congregation that reflect your concern. We all need it so please share it with us.
