



A son, Daniel Jeremy Silver, is the spiritual leader of the Temple, as was Mrs. Silver's husband.

Mrs. Silver, the former Virginia H. Horkheimer of Wheeling, W.Va., attended Goucher College in Baltimore before she married Rabbi Silver in 1922. He became spiritual leader of the Temple in 1917 when he was 24.
