by it all.




Dear Rabbi Silver:

Dear Rabbi Silver:

We join those countless others who mourn at the death of your Mother and commiserate with you at your loss.

Mrs Silver was a "beautiful" person if such an expression can be used. She had compassion, love and understanding of her fellow man. Our really first experience with her goes back exactly sixty years, April fifth, when my sister Suzanne died. At that time Mrs Silver had Rabbi Silver break a trip short so that he could officiate. But more important she took over with my parents especially my mother who was breaking up. I recall many visits as well as a renewal of faith in GOD with a conversant return to normalcy.
