The Memorial, as you have been able to see during your also in America. It has become a sacred place of pilgrimage for Jews as well as non-Jews.

It is therefore logical that all the Jews, from every country, should extend their help to it. The Memorial belongs to Jewry as a whole, which bears the responsibility for its existence and functioning.

I take the liberty to ask you to use your influence with these donors - and eventually with others - so that we should receive further contributions from them.

These contributions would constitute a valuable help to enable us to continue our sacred work.

I apologise for troubling you and thank you in advance most sincerely.

I have advanced in age, and unhappily have had the terrible pain to lose my dear wife. My only consolation is in my work for the Memorial, which I continue despite the diminution of my strength.

I renew to you my thanks and gratitude for your help, and send my best wishes for your health and happiness.
