Dear Mrs Silver,

We have retained the most agreeable and delighted remembrance of your visits to the Memorial and to my personal home.

The Friday evening which your dear husband and yourself spent with us in my home will always remain unforgettable and sacred in my mind. We were proud of the sympathy and interest of which Dr. Silver gave proofs to our Memorial and to our Centre of Jewish Contemporary Documentation, and equally of your personal interest towards our Institution.

That is why I take the liberty to appeal to you concerning the following :

Due to the cessation of the activities of the Claims Conference, the Memorial has been deprived of the greatest part of its Budget. What we receive at present from the Foundation for Jewish Culture represents only half of our previous subvention.

In consequence, we are faced with the greatest difficulties and have to look for help from our friends all over the world.

The Memorial, as you have been able to see during your visit, is the only one of its kind, not only in Europe, but also in America. It has become a sacred place of pilgrimage for Jews as well as non-Jews.

It is therefore logical that all the Jews, from every country, should extend their help to it. The Memorial belongs to Jewry as a whole, which bears the responsibility for its existence and functioning.

Due to the sympathy and understanding of your late husband, we received in 1962 a total contribution of 5.000 dollars from 10 donors, whose list of names and addresses I enclose.

I take the liberty to ask you to use your influence with these donors - and eventually with others - so that we should receive further contributions from them.


These contributions would constitute a valuable help to enable us to continue our sacred work.



I was very happy to receive your letter of the 10th March and the enclosed cheque of \$ 500.


May I ask you to kindly convey our most heartfelt thanks to the generous donors, the Samuel Rosenthal Foundation and Leighton Rosenthal.
