Dear Ernie:

This is to follow up on our brief over-lunch discussion yesterday. The Hebrew Union College and the Union of American Hebrew Congregations have launched a \$15,000,000 Development Fund. It represents their need for capital funds to enlarge the Seminary and build a branch of the Seminary in Los Angeles, to increase the Union's summer camp program, add stories to the building in New York, etc. It is the first such capital drive by the institutions of Reform life in thirty years.

I am, as you know, often at loggerheads with specific proposals of the Union, but the need for these funds is indisputable. Whatever we feel about specific programs, without a steady supply of rabbis, school texts, school programs etc., our temple and other temples would not be as effective.

This is an important campaign. It is a five-year campaign. It has been suggested as a yardstick that the men contacted consider pledging their one-year contribution to the United Jewish Appeal spread over five years. Only two hundred or so men will be contacted in The Temple and proportionally like numbers in the other Cleveland congregations. Such a capital funds drive obviously can not have mass coverage. Here are some Temple gifts for comparison: A. M. Luntz, \$10,000, Eli Goldston \$4,000, Irving Kane \$1500, Alan Geismer \$1,000, Max Eisner \$1,000, H. S. Carran \$1,000, Paul Handleman \$1,000.



Dear Bob:

I spent two days last week at The Hebrew Union College as a member of its Board of Governors. I look on the College as the most important training ground of Jewish religious leadership. The College's most critical problem is to find monies to provide tuition and subsistence help to 220 students enrolled in the rabbinic program.

It costs approximately \$3,000.00 to support a man at the College for a year. These monies are lent to the students at no interest. Upon his ordination he subscribes to an insurance policy which accrues to the College for the value of the monies he has received. It will be sometime before the first of these policies come due and until then the College must look to us to give these men the wherewithal to continue their studies.

I should like to raise enough money to provide one scholarship for the current academic year. I wonder if you will join with me in giving \$50.00 or \$100.00 to this investment in learning and leadership. If you will be kind enough to make out a check to The Hebrew Union College Scholarship Fund, I will transmit it to Cincinnati. This would be a wonderful Chanuka gift to your children and grandchildren for these are the young men who will be their rabbis and teachers.

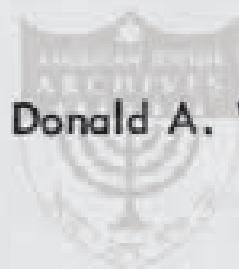

Dear Danny:

I am writing to all members of the HUC-JIR Board of Overseers in preparation for our May meeting in Cincinnati.

When we met in Los Angeles in November, 1965, Dr. Glueck made a strong plea regarding the problem of scholarships needed by the students. The Overseers thereupon decided to do something about meeting the desperate need for 100 scholarships. We cannot, for obvious reasons, go out on any major fund-raising effort for these scholarships without damaging the Reform Jewish Appeal or the Development Fund. Yet we can in a quiet, effective way do what we can in each of our communities to finance one scholarship of \$2,500 for a single student or \$3,000 for a married student from each of the Overseers.

What we are suggesting, then, is to secure the financial assistance of some generous man who has a foundation or from others who are in a position to provide a scholarship. Some congregations have done this in honor of their rabbi; some Sisterhoods or Brotherhoods have also subscribed.

I was asked to take charge of this project and see if we Overseers could put our shoulders to the wheel and help relieve the pressure from Dr. Glueck for raising scholarship funds. I am writing to you therefore, to ask your help and cooperation. Please let me hear from you.


Dear Daniel:

Scholarships are needed.


Enclosed is a list of the contributions received from alumni for the first Year in Israel program.
