I know how busy your days are and I was grateful for your patience in listening to our needs. I am grateful that you will raise the issue of the proper Chicago allocation at the appropriate time. We have received \$7500. We need to receive \$15,000. If we do, Chicago's allocation will only equal that of Detroit and Cleveland.
