Dear Rabbi Silver:

I am writing in reference to the phone call that I made with you today. As mentioned, our Sodality, a Christian action organization, is sponsoring a series of lectures this year for the student body with "Ecumenism" as its theme. Thus far, Father Best and Rev. Pennybacker have spoken explaining what Ecumenism means, etc.

If you should choose to be our guest speaker, I would appreciate your giving the student body a summary of your belief, what the Jewish community thinks of Ecumensim and what you consider is the value of interfaith dialogue.

A few other details might clarify things. Our school is on the West side of Cleveland just off Lorain and 41st Street.
