ZIONISM, ISRAEL, AND THE MIDDLE EAST CONFLICT

This Sunday, March 7th, the Akron Jewish Student Group and NOUJS will be holding an informal workshop on Israel, Zionism, and the Middle East Conflict. The purpose of the afternoon is to give Jewish students a historical background on the conflict. We are honored to have as our main speaker Rabbi Daniel Silver, noted scholar and author, who will lecture on the history of Zionist thought and also present an analysis of the Middle East Conflict from an international political perspective.
