Hall of Fame**

1990 marks the fifth anniversary of the Shaker Heights Alumni Association's Hall of Fame. The Hall of Fame was inaugurated in 1986 with the induction of ten distinguished alumni. Since that time, thirty-eight people have been inducted into the Hall of Fame. This year, ten more alumni will join their number.

Nominations to the Hall of Fame are received from Shaker Alumni and from the community at large. To be considered for induction, candidates must be graduates of the Shaker Heights school system. Inductees are chosen on the basis of their exemplary achievement in one or more of the following areas:

- arts/humanities/entertainment
- education/religion/philanthropy
- science/medicine
- law/government
- business/sports

The inductees address an assembly for high school students, to act as role models.

Many outstanding alumni have been nominated. Those not selected are automatically eligible for future consideration.

Janice Green Douglas '60

Janice Green Douglas '60 — currently serves as professor and director of the Division of Endocrinology and Hypertension of the Department of Medicine at Case Western Reserve University. Janice has done extensive research in endocrinology and hypertension and is published widely in those areas of research. She has received numerous honors and awards for her exceptional work. Janice earned her medical degree at Meharry Medical College and is a Phi Beta Kappa and magna cum laude graduate of Fisk University.



Burton W. Griffin '50

Burton W. Griffin '50 — has been a Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of Cuyahoga County since 1975. He graduated cum laude from Amherst College and attended Yale Law School. In 1964, he served as Assistant Counsel to the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy. In 1966, Burt became director of the Cleveland Legal Aid Society. In his capacity as judge he has been a Guggenheim Fellow studying sentencing at Yale Law School and was recipient of a grant from the Marshall Fund of the United States to study sentencing practices in England. Judge Griffin is a member of the faculty of the Ohio Judicial College and the National Judicial College.



Providence Pedone Hollander '44

Providence Pedone Hollander '44 — is an actress and singer who has performed with theatre companies such as The Cleveland Playhouse, Kenley Players and the Chautauqua Opera Company. Noted for her performance in the long-running production of "Jacques Brel" at Playhouse Square, she was featured in the United Artists Production of *Those Lips, Those Eyes* with Frank Langella. She has performed in numerous benefit concerts such as the Performers and Artists for Nuclear Disarmament and was voted one of Cleveland's Pacesetters by the publishers of "Greater Cleveland's Enterprising Women."

Walter T. (Ted) Olson '35

Walter T. (Ted) Olson '35 — is currently director of Build Up Greater Cleveland, an organization that pursues financing to improve local roads, bridges, public transportation, water and sewer systems. He is a graduate of DePauw University and has masters and doctorate degrees in chemistry and chemical engineering from Case Western Reserve University. Ted was a research scientist and manager with the Lewis Research Center of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration from 1942 to 1981. He directed pioneering work on high-altitude combustion for jet engines, high-energy rocket propellants for space flight, electric rockets, fuel cells and solar energy conversion.




Barbara Shultz Robinson '47

Barbara Shultz Robinson '47 — was recently appointed to a second term as Chair of the Ohio Arts Council by Governor Richard Celeste and was honored by the YWCA as a Career Woman of Achievement. Barbara graduated with highest honors from Wellesley College and from the Harvard/Radcliffe Program in Business Administration. She was a piano soloist with the Boston Pops Orchestra and the New England Conservatory Orchestra. She chairs the Board of Trustees of the Cleveland Institute of Music and serves as a board member for numerous arts organizations.

David B. Roth '67

David B. Roth '67 — is currently executive director of Cleveland Works and is engaged in the practice of law. David studied history at Rockford College and attended Cleveland Marshall Law School. He is the former President of Ohio Works and was Executive Director of the Free Clinic of Greater Cleveland for a number of years. David serves on the board of trustees of many local civic and arts organizations. He was honored by the Cuyahoga County Community Health Board for ten years of outstanding service to mental health, by the Cleveland Ethical Society for outstanding humanism and received the American Jewish Committee's Isaiah Award (on behalf of the Free Clinic).



Scott Siegler '65

Scott Siegler '65 — is president of Columbia Pictures Television. Formerly with Tri-Star Pictures, Scott had a hand in developing such shows as "Simon and Simon," "Family Ties," and "My Two Dads." He studied philosophy as an undergraduate and has two masters degrees, in theatre and in English literature. He studied at the University of Toronto with Marshall McLuhan and studied directing at the American Film Institute in Los Angeles. In 1976 he worked as assistant producer on "Cloud Dancer" with David Carradine and "The Manitou" with Tony Curtis. From there he worked his way up through comedy and drama management at NBC, CBS, Warner Brothers and Tri-Star.



Rabbi Daniel J. Silver '45

Rabbi Daniel J. Silver '45 — Dr. Silver served as Rabbi of The Temple of Cleveland from 1956 until 1989. He attended Harvard University, the Hebrew Union College and earned his doctorate at the University of Chicago. He was active in theological organizations both locally and on a national level and served on the faculty of Case Western Reserve University and Cleveland State University. In addition, he served as vice president of the Cleveland Museum of Art for almost twenty years. Dr. Silver was the author of a number of books dealing with the scriptures, Judaism and ethics.

Milan Tiff '68

Milan Tiff '68 — is an artist, art consultant, athlete, physical training and track and field coach. A former national scholastic triple-jump champion and record holder and member of the Ohio Track and Field Hall of Fame, Milan received numerous athletic awards throughout the world, notably being three time NCAA and American triple-jump champion and record holder, and the current World Masters triple-jump champion and record holder. He is physical training consultant to many motion picture and film industry celebrity clients and is consulting jumping coach at UCLA and the University of Southern California in Los Angeles. Milan is also an artist and art consultant and owns galleries in Carmel and Los Angeles.



William R. Van Aken '30

William R. Van Aken '30 — is an attorney who has been in the practice of law for fifty years. He has held a number of offices in the Ohio State Bar Association, including president and was honored twice as Ohio State Bar Foundation Laureate for outstanding research in law and government. William attended Lafayette College and Western Reserve Law School. In addition, he is past president of the Early Settlers Association, the Inter-Museum Council and of Heather Hill Hospital. William Van Aken is author of the book *Buckeye Barrister: The First Hundred Years of the Ohio State Bar Association*.


