
I am pleased to see that you are taking the initiative of receiving contributions for the reconstruction of the bombed Negro Baptist church in Birmingham.

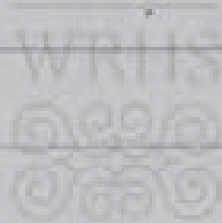

Dear Daniel:

I am enclosing an article which appeared in a recent edition of the Birmingham News, setting up a trust fund and outlining the disbursements of the fund.

I called the Rev. J. H. Cross, who is the pastor of the Sixteenth Street Baptist Church, and he stated that the colored people had set up their own fund committee. It is The Building Fund Committee, Sixteenth Street Baptist Church. Checks made payable to that committee are to be mailed either to Citizens Federal Savings and Loan Association, 1523 Fifth Avenue North, which is owned, controlled, and does business with colored people only, or to Rev. J. H. Cross, P. O. Box 1049, Birmingham.

One of the local T-V stations had started a fund which, you will notice from the enclosed article, has been combined with the white group.

I am making an effort to combine the white and colored groups and in that connection, I have spoken with Douglas Arant, one of the laymen in the white group (this group is being constantly enlarged), and he has expressed himself as being heartily in favor of the move. May I suggest that you wait a few days and if there has been no consolidation or merger, I will advise you. If you do not hear from me, use your own judgment.

You will notice from the enclosed article that it is the announced desire of the local white people to make amends themselves but on the other hand, it would appear that they intend to keep a close rein on the expenses and channel the excess funds, if any, as they see fit.

Mother has just called and read me a portion of Del's letter. The questions Del asks aren't easy to answer. Many of us are still in a state of shock. We had private armed guards at both Emanuel and Beth-El during Rosh Hashonah. We expect to do the same for Yom Kippur. In addition, for Rosh Hashonah, I secured policemen in police cars which were stationed at each of the

Temples. This again will be repeated during Yom Kippur. You may remember that several years ago, sticks of dynamite were found at Beth-El and in a car abandoned at Emanuel.

I would like to say that a sense of revulsion has been shown by the people here. Undoubtedly, many white people are sick at heart. But, I must admit that there are many who are willing to blame the negroes for the bombing and there are those who would not be unhappy if many more negroes were killed. I came up on the elevator a few minutes ago with a prominent white attorney who told me he felt very low because his dog had just died, but not one word did he say about how he felt about the four negro children being killed.

I just left the Probate Court where I represented the administrator of an estate who is a member of the Housing Authority of the City of Birmingham. He is sure that dynamite had been stored at the church at all times, and that this was either an accidental explosion or was done intentionally so that Martin Luther King could raise another million dollars.

Mother and I had open house on the first day of Rosh Hashonah after services. Yesterday the past president of Temple Emanuel and the now president of the Jewish Community Council complained about Martin Luther King's funeral sermon Wednesday, that the negro crowd almost got out of hand and started a demonstration and that he was appalled at what might have happened had not the Police Department vigorously enforced order. When the point was made that the negroes had shown remarkable restraint and he was reminded of the Sternists and Irgunists, he sheepishly admitted that was different because what they did was for our people.

On the other hand, attendance at the integrated schools has increased each day since the bombing. There will be some disposition on the part of the whites to yield something to the colored people, but we are now in a state of apathy. A talk that a liberal attorney, one who was instrumental in forcing reapportionment in the Federal Court for our State Legislature wherein he castigated the moderates for their silence and a hard-hitting charge to the Grand Jury by one of our District Judges, copy of which I am enclosing, are epilogues to the bombing and I feel and hope will do something to arouse the white citizenry to affirmative action, which would be nothing more or less than yielding to the edict of the Supreme Court.

I could go on and on but we are deeply grateful that these problems do not affect you as directly as they do us. Mother joins me in being thankful that you and Del and the children are far removed from this sick city. We wish you and your family a healthy and happy new year. Please give our regards to your mother and father.

Dear Mr. Taft:

I read with satisfaction of the establishment of a national committee to aid in the rebuilding of the 16th Street Baptist Church and in providing relief to the families of the victims. The day after the blast I announced in the Cleveland papers my desire to initiate such a campaign in Cleveland, and I am pleased to tell you that over \$1200.00 has come in as a result of my appeal.

I will be happy to cooperate with your national committee in any way that I can. At the moment I am particularly concerned about the disbursement of funds raised. It is my understanding that there are now, in Birmingham, two separate funds -- the Building Fund Committee of the 16th Street Baptist Church, of which the Reverend J. H. Cross is Pastor and which banks at the Citizen's Federal Savings and Loan Association (a Negro bank); and the 16th Street Baptist Memorial Fund, headed by a group of white leaders and ministers, which banks at the Birmingham Trust and the Birmingham First National. Through family in Birmingham I have been told that all efforts to coordinate the activities of these two groups have failed. The point at issue seems to be the desire by the white Board to extend relief from the monies raised to both white and colored who have been injured during the recent violence and to set limits to the church's rebuilding plans. The Negro group is concerned that there will not be sufficient monies for their sanctuary, that whites are receiving monies not intended for them by the donors, and that they will lose control of their building. In view of this incredible confusion, it is important that your committee make public its policy for the disbursement of funds raised. I can foresee quite a

scandal if they are channeled through an all-white committee which is being opposed by the 16th Street Church and Negro leadership. I would hope that your committee would lend its good offices to a quick resolution of this incredible embarrassment.

May I request from you guidance in the matter of the transmission of the funds that I have raised, and may I offer my services in any way that I can be of help.

He called me today to thank me for informing him about a situation about which he was ignorant and to inform me that he had spoken to Reverend Cross and Drew Pearson and that there was no problem in arranging relationships between the church and the national group. The monies will be first used for the rebuilding of the sanctuary and, if there is any surplus, for the establishment of an interracial center. I didn't tell him that I thought the latter was a pipe-dream. He told me that the inspiration for the Birmingham white committee had come largely through his suggestion and through the Taft radio outlet in town. He has brought pressure already for a cooperative effort. Perhaps you can achieve something by working with his people in town.

We have raised some \$1400.00, and my plan is right after Yom Kippur to mail it down directly to Cross.

Dear Myron:

I am in receipt of your kind letter of September 25 and grateful for the checks it contained. You raised, quite properly, the question of the national committee and the monies it will raise. I have been withholding the mailing of these checks until I hear from Charles Taft in answer to several queries. Frankly, my major concern is this: there are now, in Birmingham, two segregated committees, the Negro church, its pastor and the Negro community generally on the one hand, and a group of white citizens on the other. The whites refuse to sit in joint deliberation. They insist on control of the church's rebuilding program and on the availability of funds for both white and Negro victims of the racial unrest. The Negro group is insisting on cooperative discussion and that the funds be used for the church and for the Negro victims. Quite a scandal would develop if the national committee were to channel its funds through a segregated group. I have written for clarification. I do not know the national committee's relationship to either of these groups.

More as it develops.
