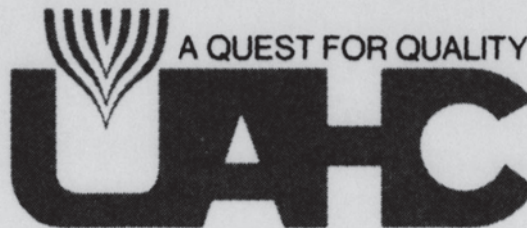

The following is the plan which I would suggest for your involvement in our Regional Biennial, October 24 - 26 at the Niagara Hilton in Niagara Falls, N.Y.


1. Saturday, 9:45 - 10:30 a.m. to deliver the Shabbat Lecture entitled "Morning With Moses" - from a forthcoming book.


Subject Tenth Anniversary Biennial

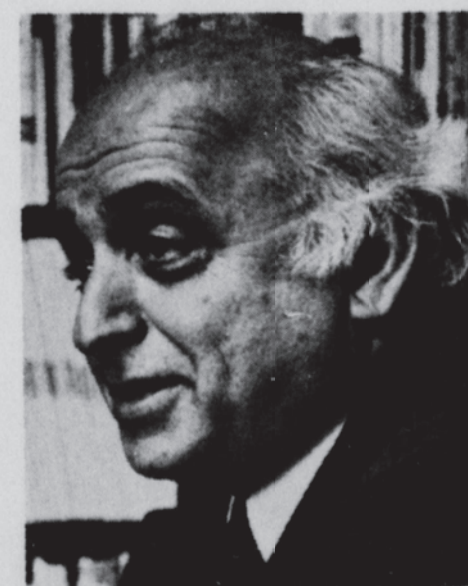
