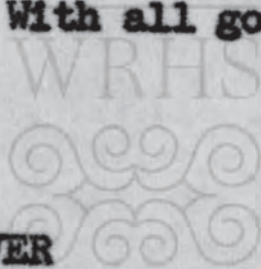


Dear Rabbi Silver:
