Dear Dan:



Thanks so much for your kind offer to make arrangements for our forthcoming visit in Cleveland.



Dear Rabbi,


I have just participated in a "Conference Call" and meeting of our Worcester Jewish community leadership. With the gravity of the overseas situation, all of us find it painfully frustrating to feel so deeply while being relatively unable to help. We shall, of course, raise all the money possible and make our concern known to President Johnson. Is it possible that our generation will be witness to the obliteration of six million bretheren twice?

Gene and I will long remember our delight in taking part in the reunion of my Confirmation class. The warmth and homogeneity of that occasion, and all the fun that accompanied it, was a rare and special treat. I continue to feel a strong attachment toward The Temple because I have reached the conclusion that my brief association with it and with your father have remained a lasting inspiration to me.
