## GORBACHEV

Is he a breath of fresh air in the world of super-power politics or simply a more clever and more astute cold-war leader? He will be in Washington on December 7 in order to sign the I N F treaty, which calls for the destruction of medium-range nuclear weapons. Is this the act of a man who is devoted to peace---or simply a strategy by a clever diplomat who recognizes that his country needs a few years to concentrate on domestic economic development before she can assume, again, her move to dominate the world?

IN JUST TWO-AND-A-HALF YEARS, MIKHAIL GORBACHEV
HAS CAPTURED THE IMAGINATION OF THE WORLD. WHEN HE WAS
ELECTED GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY, FEW BESIDE
KREMLINOLOGISTS HAD HEARD OF HIM. Now THEY HAVE.
THEY KNOW HIM TO BE ARTICULATE, PLEASANT, DIPLOMATIC, AND
QUITE AWARE OF THE WISHES AND HOPES OF THE WORLD. THEY KNOW
HIM TO BE THE FIRST SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY
WHO DRESSES, SPEAKS, AND THINKS LIKE A WESTERNER---AND THE
FIRST SECRETARY GENERAL SINCE LENIN TO HAVE A UNIVERSITY
DEGREE. G. TOTALL THE MESSEN
SELECTION.

HE IS ALSO THE FIRST GENERAL SECRETARY WHOSE POLITICAL LIFE DOES NOT GO BACK TO THE PERIOD OF STALIN. GORBACHEV WAS 54 WHEN HE ASCENDED TO HIS OFFICE IN 1985.

GORBACHEV IS THE SON AND GRANDSON OF PEASANTS.

HE WAS RAISED IN THE LITTLE VILLAGE OF PRIBOLNOYA, WHICH IS
IN THE NORTH CAUCASUS DISTRICT OF STAVROPOL. HE WAS TOO YOUNG
FOR ACTIVE SERVICE IN THE SECOND WORLD WAR AND SPENT THE
WAR YEARS IN SCHOOL. DURING THE LONG SUMMER MONTHS HE WORKED
AS AN AUTO MECHANIC OR AS A HELPER IN THE FIELDS. HIS YOUTH
AND SCHOOLING POINT UP CERTAIN THINGS ABOUT GORBACHEV: HIS
NATIVE ABILITY HIS WILLINGNESS TO DO HARD WORK UNCOMPLAININGLY.

LAD FROM THE NORTH CAUCASUS TO WIN A SCHOLARSHIP TO MOSCOW

UNIVERSITY--WHICH IN THOSE DAYS HAD A STUDENT BODY MADE UP

OF THE SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF THE ELITE OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY.

HE STUDIED LAW AT THE UNIVERSITY, A SKILL WHICH PROVED USEFUL

IN HIS LATER CAREER. MOSCOW UNIVERSITY'S LAW FACULTY

PRACTICALLY THE ONLY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION IN THE COUNTRY

WHICH STUDENTS FORMAL TRAINING IN THE ART OF ORATORY

--HOW TO GIVE WIMPRESSIVE SPEECH AND TO PRESENT A CASE AND

TO ASK RELEVANT QUESTIONS AND TO CONDUCT INTERROGATIONS.

AS A RESULT, GORBACHEV IS PROBABLY ONE OF THE BEST SPEAKERS

WHO HAS EVER BEEN IN THE HIGHER ECHELONS OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY.

GORBACHEV SPENT FIVE YEARS AT THE UNIVERSITY, WHERE HE STUDIED DILIGENTLY, MARRIED, PASSED HIS EXAMS, AND THEN HE WAS SENT BACK TO STAVROPOL TO WORK FOR THE KOMSOMOL, THE YOUTH WING OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY, A MINOR JOB FOR A GRADUATE OF MOSCOW UNIVERSITY. GORBACHEV IS A MAN WHO TAKES WHAT COMES HIS WAY IN STRIDE. HE BUCKLED DOWN TO HIS MINOR ASSIGNMENT AND WAS SOON MOVING SWIFTLY UP THE LADDER.

IT TURNS OUT THAT HE WAS FORTUNATE TO BE SENT BACK TO STAVROPOL. STAVROPOL IS NOT ONLY A DISTRICT WHICH INCLUDES SOME OF THE GREAT PRAIRIES OF THE SOVIET CAUCASUS. IT IS ALSO AN AREA WHICH HAS MANY OF THE DACHAS OF LEADERS OF THE SOVIET PARTY, MEN WHOM GORBACHEV WAS ABLE TO MEET AND IMPRESS.

ABLE, WILLING, RESOLUTE, HE MOVED QUICKLY THROUGH
THE RANKS OF THE KOMSOMOL AND GRADUATED TO WORK FOR THE PARTY
ITSELF WHEN HE BECAME THE FIRST SECRETARY FOR AGRICULTURE
FOR THE STAVROPOL AREA. TRUE TO HIS DOGGED DETERMINATION,
HE ENROLLED IN A 5-YEAR EXTENSION COURSE IN THE STAVROPOL
AGRICULTURE INSTITUTE IN ORDER TO FAMILIARIZE HIMSELF WITH
THE PROBLEMS OF AGRICULTURE. AGRICULTURE HAS BEEN THE
STUMBLING BLOCK OF THE SOVIET ECONOMY FOR DECADES, AND
GORBACHEV WAS ABLE TO DO SOME USEFUL WORK WHICH BROUGHT HIM
ATTENTION---AND TO MOSCOW TO FILL A SENIOR POST IN THE
DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

IN 197 HE WAS MADE A PROVISIONAL MEMBER OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE, THE 300-PERSON BODY WHICH CARRIES OUT THE ACTIVITIES OF GOVERNING THE STATE.

THE 70s WERE A TIME OF RAPID CHANGE. KHRUSHCHEV HAD FALLEN. BREZHNEV WOULD FALL. ANDROPOV WOULD LAST BUT I4 MONTHS, CHERNENKO HARDLY THAT. EACH NEW GENERAL SECRETARY MEANT A RESHUFFLING OF THE MEMBERS OF THE POLITBURO AND OF THE OFFICIALS IMMEDIATELY BELOW IT. GORBACHEV SEEMS TO HAVE SIDED LARGELY WITH THE ANDROPOVGROUP, THE MOST REFORM-MINDED OF THE GROUPS, BUT HE REMAINED ON GOOD TERMS, AS FAR AS HE COULD, WITH EVERYONE. GORBACHEV IS A MAN WHO DOES WHAT IS ASKED OF HIM AND WHO MAKES SURE HIS CONTACTS ARE SOLID.

HE SERVED FOR A WHILE AS SECRETARY OF THE BUREAU OF AGRICULTURE AND FOR A WHILE IN THE KGB. HE BEGAN TO BE POSTED ON TRIPS ABROAD AND TO BE THOUGHT OF AS A SENIOR MEMBER OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY. DURING ANDROPOV'S SHORT REIGN, HE BECAME A TRUSTED LIEUTENANT WHO WAS KEPT CLOSE AT HAND AND A PROVISIONAL MEMBER OF THE POLITBURO.

THE SOVIET GOVERNMENT IS NOT A DICTATORSHIP TODAY.

IT IS AN OLIGARCHY. AT THE TOP ARE A GROUP OF MEN,

THE POLITBURO, WHO DETERMINE POLICIES OF THE COUNTRY.

ALL THE WAY DOWN THE LINE AND THROUGH THE SYSTEM THE

PATTERN IS FOR POLICIES TO BE SET FROM ABOVE AND CARRIED

OUT BELOW.

IN MARCH OF 1985 CHERNENKO DIED. GORBACHEV WAS

ONE OF THE FEW NATURAL LEADERS TO WHOM THE SOVIETS MIGHT

TURN, AND THEY DID. WHAT IMMEDIATELY STRUCK OUTSIDERS WAS

HIS AGE--54, COMPARED TO THE 70s AND 80s OF HIS PREDECESSORS-
AT RECOGNIZED THE URGENT NEED TO REVISE SOME MAJOR PARTS OF

THE SOVIET SYSTEM--INCLUDING THE WAYS POLICIES ARE MADE

AND CARRIED OUT.

GORBACHEV IS PART OF A GENERATION WHICH IS YOUNGER.

MORE FLEXIBLE. MORE DETERMINED TO LIVE BY WORLD STANDARDS.

HE AND MANY OF HIS PEERS ARE DETERMINED TO HELP THEIR

COUNTRY OUT OF ITS LONG ECONOMIC SLIDE--CREATED LARGELY BY

BAD AGRICULTURAL AND INDUSTRIAL POLICIES WHICH SET HEAVY

INDUSTRY ABOVE CONSUMER GOODS--AND OUT OF A FREE-WHEELING.

BLUSTERING MILITARY POSTURE.

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DURING THE OPENING DAYS OF HIS ADMINISTRATION,
WHICH IS NOW ONLY TWO-AND-A-HALF YEARS MR. GORBACHEV
INTRODUCED TWO RUSSIAN WORDS INTO THE VOCABULARY OF
INTERNATIONAL RELATIONSHIPS. THE FIRST HAS TO DO
WITH ECONOMIC POLICY--PERESTROIKA, A TECHNICAL RESTRUCTURING.
THE GOAL WAS TO BREAK UP ENCRUSTED. INEFFICIENT. SHODDY
PRODUCTION UNITS WHICH PROMOTED WASTE AND CORRUPTION.
MUCH OF THE PROBLEM WAS CAUSED BY CENTRAL MINISTRIES AND
COMMITTEES AND BUREAUS WHICH RUN THE 48 THOUSAND STATE
ENTERPRISES FROM MOSCOW. PERESTROIKA IS A PROGRAM TO
DECENTRALIZE. TO STIMULATE MORE FACTORY. FARM. AND PRIVATE
ACCOUNTABILITY. SELF-FINANCING. SELF-RELIANCE AND

THE SECOND TERM IS GLASNOST, WHICH MEANS OPENNESS,

FREEING THE MEDIA TO EXPOSE BUREAUCRATIC INEFFICIENCY, ARROGANCE,

AND CORRUPTION. THE SOVIET MEDIA NOW CAN OPEN ITS COLUMNS TO

TALES OF MISUSE AND CORRUPTION. YET IN A SOCIETY AS COMPLEX

AND AS STRICTLY RUN AS THE SOVIET, THE INTRODUCTION OF A BIT

OF MEDIA FREEDOM CAN BE QUITE DIFFICULT. THERE IS A PROBLEM


OF LIMITS. THE SOVIET UNION MAY NOT BE A DICTATORSHIP, BUT

IT IS ALSO NOT A DEMOCRACY.

THE FREEDOM TO CRITICIZE AN INNEFICIENT AND CORRUPT STATE ENTERPRISE CAN BEGIN WITH THE BEST OF INTENTIONS AND END IN CAUSING A SURGE OF WHAT THE GOVERNMENT CONSIDERS SUBVERSION. THERE ARE OVER 700 THOUSAND BUREAUCRATS RESPONSIBLE FOR SETTING PRICES AND MAKING CENTRAL PLANS IN THE SOVIET UNION. EACH OF THEM SEES HIS JOB IN A WAY THREATENED. THE RESULT AS BEEN THAT THERE HAS BEEN MORE TALK THAN ACTION AND A GREAT DEAL OF CONFUSION AS THE NEW POLICIES ARE ENFORCED.

UNDER GORBACHEV THE SOVIET UNION IS TRYING TO DO WHAT CHINA HAS TRIED TO DO UNDER DENG--THAT IS, TO MODERNIZE THE SOCIETY, TO MODERNIZE ITS ECONOMIC POLICIES, TO PERMIT A DEGREE OF SELF-CRITICISM, BUT TO ENTER THIS FREER WORLD WITHOUT SURRENDERING THE CENTRAL ECONOMIC CONCEPT OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY: THE CENTRAL CONTROL OF THE ECONOMY.

GREATER FREEDOM FOR THE LOCAL UNITS AND A CONTINUATION OF LARGE-SCALE CENTRAL CONTROL ARE POLICIES WHICH TO A LARGE DEGREE CONTRADICT EACH OTHER.



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THE SOVIET UNION TODAY IS AN OLIGARCHY. POWER
RESTS WITH THE COMMUNIST PARTYAND PROGRESSIVELY UPWARD
WITH ITS RANKING BUREAUS AND COMMITTEES UNTIL ONE COMES
TO THE POLITBURO INCLUDES OF GORBACHEV'S GENERATION
WHO UNDERSTAND THE NEED FOR THESE PROGRAMS AND CHANGES.
THE POLITBURO ALSO INCLUDES OLDER MEN, AND MEN OF GORBACHEV'S
OWN AGE, WHO ARE MORE INCLINED TO CONTINUE THE CENTRALIZATION
OF AUTHORITY IN THE HANDS OF MOSCOW. THEY ARGUE THAT TO GIVE
TOO MUCH AUTHORITY TO INDIVIDUAL FACTORIES OR TO INDIVIDUAL
COLLECTIVE FARMS, TO CRITICIZE AND TO SET THEIR OWN AGENDAS
IS ULTIMATELY TO BRING THE STATUS OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY
INTO QUESTION.

GORBACHEV SPEAKS FORTHRIGHTLY BUT, LIKE THE CAREFUL POLITICIAN HE IS, IS MOVING SLOWLY. WITH FEW EXCEPTIONS, HE HAS NOT YET FORCED HIS VIEWS ON SOVIET SOCIETY.

THE RUSSIANS ARE HEAVY DRINKERS. DURING A RECENT YEAR THE TOTAL PURCHASE OF VODKA WAS ABOUT 22 BILLION RUBLES OUT OF A TOTAL STATE BUDGET OF \$\infty\$75 BILLION RUBLES. BETWEEN 1970 AND 1983, THE STATE PRODUCTION OF VODKA AND WINE INCREASED BY 38 PERCENT AND 97 PERCENT RESPECTIVELY.

THERE COMES A POINT WHEN THE ECONOMIC BENEFITS OF ALCOHOL REVENUES TO THE STATE ARE OUTWEIGHED BY THE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC COSTS OF HEAVY DRINKING: INCREASING CRIME, POOR PRODUCTIVITY, ABSENTEEISM, A LARGER NUMBER OF PROBLEM CHILDREN OF ALCOHOLIC PARENTS, REDUCED LIFE EXPECTANCY, AND ALCOHOL-RELATED HEALTH PROBLEMS.

ONE MONTH AFTER GORBACHEV CAME
INTO OFFICE, A PRESS CAMPAIGN BEGAN AGAINST ALCOHOLISM AND
DRINKING. THE MINIMUM AGE FOR PURCHASING ALCOHOL WAS RAISED
FROM 18 TO 21. ALCOHOL COULD NO LONGER BE SOLD FROM
ORDINARY FOOD STORES. WINE SHOPS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO SELL
ANY ALCOHOL BEFORE 2 P.M., NOR ARE RESTAURANTS PERMITTED
TO SELL ALCOHOL WITH LUNCH. STIFF PENALTIES WERE INTRODUCED
FOR PRIVATE STILLS. BEING DRUNK IN A PUBLIC PLACE BECAME
PUNISHABLE BY A FINE, STARTING AT 500 RUBLES.

THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL DROPPED, BUT THERE
WERE DIFFICULTIES. MANY FARMS WHICH PRODUCED HOPS FOR THE GRAIN
AND FRUIT FOR THE WINE NEARLY WENT BANKRUPT. THE STATE SUFFERED
A LOSS OF REVENUE. IN THIS CASE GORBACHEV HAS NOT
COMPROMISED AND THE PROGRAM GOES ON.

ANOTHER ISSUE--A MORE CENTRAL AND DIFFICULT ISSUE-WAS TO REORGANIZE THE MANAGEMENT OF THE AGRICULTURE SYSTEM
WHICH IS SO BASIC TO THE SOVIET ECONOMY. AGRICULTURAL CONTROL
HAD BEEN DIVIDED AMONG SOME I6 BUREAUS IN MOSCOW. IT WOULD
NOW BE CENTERED IN ONE AGRICULTURE-INDUSTRIAL DEPARTMENT.
THE GOALS OF THIS EFFORT HAVE NOT ALL. EVEN SIGNIFICANTLY,
BEEN MET, BUT THERE IS NOW ONE ADDRESS FOR GROUPS TO ADDRESS
THEIR COMPLAINTS AND THEIR COMMENTS--AND ONE SOURCE FOR COMMANDS.

AND TRANSLATED DIRECTLY TO THE COUNTRY WITHOUT BEING DIVIDED

AMONG VARIOUS CENTRAL OFFICES AND THEIR VARIOUS INTERPRETATIONS.

GORBACHEV IS ATTEMPTING TO LIMIT POLICY AUTHORITY TO ONE

CENTRAL AGENCY--AND AT THE SAME TIME TO BESTOW MUCH WIDER

AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT POLICIES TO LOCAL UNITS.

YOU WILL FIND IN THE SOVIET UNION TODAY VERY LITTLE
OPPOSITION TO PERESTROIKA--THAT IS, VERY LITTLE OPPOSITION
IN THEORY. EVERYONE RECOGNIZES PAST FAILURES AND THE NEED
FOR MORE LOCAL AUTHORITY. BUT IN PRACTICE PERESTROIKA IS
ANOTHER MATTER. THE SOVIET UNION LOOKS UNBALANCED. THE
MILITARY-INDUSTRIAL COMPLES APPEARS TO BE EFFICIENT, WELL-EQUIPPED,
AND WELL-FINANCED. THERE IS A GROUP OF CITIZENS IN MOSCOW AND
IN EVERY MAJOR CITY THAT LIVES WELL.

CONTINUE

BUT THE AVERAGE RUSSIAN DOES NOT LIVE WELL.

FIVE-YEAR PLAN AFTER FIVE-YEAR PLAN HAS TALKED ABOUT RAISING
THE LEVEL OF CONSUMER PRODUCTS AND THE STANDARD OF LIVING,
BUT HAS FAILED TO DO SO.

AND THERE ARE THE OLD-LINE COMMUNIST PARTY MEMBERS WHO HAVE BENEFITTED FROM THE OLD SYSTEM FOR YEARS. THERE IS THE FEAR IN EVERYONE THAT IF PLANS MADE IN AND BY A CENTRAL AUTHORITY ARE LEFT TO LOCAL UNITS TO CARRY OUT THAT THEY WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GET THE SUPPORT, THE TOOLS, THE EQUIPMENT THEY NEED. IT IS IMMENSELY DIFFICULT TO CHANGE A SYSTEM OF CENTRAL PLANNING TO ONE OF PLURALISM AND DIVERSITY AND--AT THE SAME TIME--TO DO SO WITHIN THE CONTEXT OF GLASNOST, OPEN CRITICISM OF A SOCIETY WHERE POLITICAL CRITICISM IS NOT LEGITIMATE.

CATCH UP WITH THE INDUSTRY AND AGRICULTURE OF THE WEST.

MR. GORBACHEV HAS APPARENTLY TAKEN A DIFFERENT LINE IN

FOREIGN POLICY FROM HIS PREDECESSORS. THE BLUNDERING AND

BLUSTERING "WE WILL BURY YOU" OF KHRUSHCHEV HAS GIVEN WAY

TO PROGRAMS WHICH SHOW SIGNS OF BEING CAREFULLY CONSIDERED

AND TO OFFER SOME POSSIBILITY FOR AT LEAST A TEMPORARY

REPRIEVE FROM THE MANY COSTS OF THE ARMS RACE.

On Monday of this past week, at the 70th anniversary meeting of the Central Committee of the Communist Party, celebrating the Russian Revolution, Mr. Gorbachev in a long speech said that in Washington he would sign the I N F treaty and move for a comparable breakthrough on a treaty reducing long-range nuclear weapons and banning weapons from space. He said:

THE GROWING DANCER THAT WEAPONS MAY BE PERFECTED

TO A POINT WHERE THEY WILL BECOME UNCONTROLLABLE

IS URGING US TO WASTE NO TIME. THAT IS WHY WE WILL

WORK UNREMITTINGLY AT THESE MEETINGS FOR A PALPABLE

BREAKTHROUGH, FOR CONCRETE RESULTS, REDUCING STRATEGIC

OFFENSIVE ARMAMENTS AND BARRING WEAPONS FROM OUTER

SPACE--THE KEY TO REMOVING THE NUCLEAR THREAT.

WHAT MIKHAIL GORBACHEV HAS DONE IN HIS TWO-AND-A-HALF YEARS IN OFFICE IS TO PUT THE UNITED STATES ON THE DEFENSIVE. HIS DIPLOMACY IS SKILLFUL. IN THE BATTLE FOR THE MINDS OF EUROPE HE HAS MADE THE SOVIET UNION SEEM A WILLING PARTNER IN THE ATTEMPT TO DE-ESCALATE THE ARMS RACE. HE DID THIS BY PROPOSING A UNILATERAL BAN ON NUCLEAR AND BY PROPOSING THE ELIMINATION OF CHEMICAL WEAPONS. THE FIRST CONCRETE RESULT WILL BE THE SIGNING NEXT MONTH OF THE INF TREATY.

THE QUESTION REMAINS. IS THIS SIMPLY A PLOY
DESIGNED TO GIVE THE SOVIET UNION TIME TO REBUILD ITS
ECONOMY WITHOUT LOSING ANY OF ITS MILITARY ADVANTAGES
--OR IS THIS THE TALK OF A MAN WHO GENUINELY AND HONESTLY
WISHES TO END THE ARMS RACE? HE HAS TALKED OF GETTING OUT
OF AFGHANISTAN, BUT RUSSIAN FORCES ARE STILL THERE.
IN THE BATTLE BETWEEN IRAN AND IRAQ HE HAS SIDED WITH THE
WEST IN KEEPING THE PERSIAN GULF OPEN--AND THEN SOUGHT TO
ARM AND SIGN OIL LEASE AGREEMENTS WITH IRAN. HE HAS SUPPLIED
THE SANDANISTA GOVERNMENT IN NICARAGUA. THE SOVIET MILITARY
BUDGET REMAINS HIGH.

A CLASSIC CASE IN POINT REVOLVES AROUND THE REFUSENIKS, WHO ARE A CONSTANT SOURCE OF EMBARRASSMENT TO THE SOVIET UNION. GORBACHEV KNOWS THIS. HE HAS AGREED TO LET SOME 10 THOUSAND OUT AT ABOUT THE RATE OF 900 A MONTH. HE HAS SEEN TO IT THAT THOSE WHO COME INCLUDE THE MORE NOTABLE OF THE REFUSENIKS. BUT HE HAS ALSO PASSED A LAW THAT THE ONLY ONES WHO CAN LEAVE THE SOVIET UNION ARE THOSE WHO HAVE IMMEDIATE FAMILY OUTSIDE--HUSBANDS, WIVES, PARENTS, BROTHERS, OR SISTERS. AS SOON AS THE 10 THOUSAND OR SO LEAVE, THERE WILL BE SOME 400 THOUSAND STILL LOCKED IN THE TRAP. GORBACHEV SEEMS TO BE COUNTING ON THE FACT THAT WITHOUT PUBLICITY THE MAJOR REFUSENIKS ENJOYED, THE WORLD WILL FORGET THIS HUMAN RIGHTES PROBLEM.

OR, TAKE ISRAEL THE ISSUE OF THE PROPOSED INTERNATIONAL COMPERENCE ON PEACE IN THE MIDDLE EAST.

ISRAEL HAS SAID THAT SHE WILL NOT SIT DOWN WITH ANY POWER WHICH DOES NOT HAVE DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS WITH HER.

RUSSIA HAS NOT HAD AN EMBASSY IN ISRAEL FOR A DOZEN YEARS.

THREE MONTHS AGO, THE SOVIET LEADER SENT A SMALL NUMBER OF MINOR-LEAGUE RUSSIAN COUNCILAR OFFICIALS, PRESUMEDLY TO QUESTION ISRAEL'S FITNESS FOR A RE-ESTABLISHED EMBASSY.

NO DECISION ON THE EMBASSY HAS BEEN FORTHCOMING, BUT THESE MINOR RUSSIAN DIPLOMATS REMAIN IN ISRAEL--IN ORDER TO MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR GORBACHEV TO SAY THAT RUSSIA DOES HAVE SOME TIES WITH ISRAEL AND, THEREFORE, TO CLAIM HIS ROLE, HIS SEAT, AT SUCH AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE.

GORBACHEV IS AN APPARATCHNIK, A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY WHO HAS WORKED HIS WAY UP THROUGH THE RANKS. HE HAS WORKED WITH THE OLD SCHOOL. HE IS NOT COMPLETELY HIS OWN MAN, AS WAS SHOWN DRAMATICALLY IN THE LAST SEVERAL WEEKS. GEORGE SCHULTZ WENT TO MOSCOW TO FIRM THE DATE FOR THE WASHINGTON SUMMIT. HE LEFT MOSCOW WITHOUT A DATE--AND WITH THE RUSSIAN PRESS CLAIMING THAT MR. GORBACHEV WAS NOT PREPARED TO COME TO THE SUMMIT UNLESS MAJOR PROGRESS WAS MADE LIMITING THE STAR WARS INITIATIVE.

Two days later Mr. Schultz's Russian counterpart, Mr. Shevardnadze, came to Washington with a letter which said that December 7 would be an appropriate date and that Mr. Gorbachev would be there.

WHAT HAPPENED? THERE HAD BEEN A FULL MEETING OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE ON OCTOBER 2I, AND DURING THAT MEETING BORIS YELTSIN--TIL THEN A FIRM ALLY OF GORBACHEV AND HIS POLICIES--APPARENTLY ATTACKED MR. GORBACHEV FOR HAVING ENGENDERED A PERSONALITY CULT. WHAT ACTUALLY HAPPENED WE DON'T KNOW. YELTSIN'S SPEECH SEEMS TO HAVE UNLEASHED A BROUHAHA OF COMMENTS, PRO AND CON, AND IT IS THIS COMMOTION THAT WAS BLAMED FOR THE DELAY IN ACKNOWLEDGING THE INVITATION TO THE SUMMIT.

APPARENTLY, THERE IS OPPOSITION TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF GORBACHEV'S PROGRAM AND TO ITS PACE. YELTSIN'S COMPLAINTS SEEM TO BE THAT IT'S TOO SLOW. THIS MORNING'S NEW YORK TIMES CARRIED AN INTERESTING ARTICLE REPORTING COMPLAINTS THAT IT'S GOING TOO FAST. THAT TIMES ARTICLE DESCRIBES A "SECRET" REPORT OF THE KOMSOMOL, THE YOUTH WING OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY. THE REPORT EMPHASIZES THE NEED TO BRING UNDER KOMSOMOL CONTROL THE BURGEONING NUMBER OF SMALL GROUPS TAKING GORBACHEV AND HIS GLASNOST AT FACE VALUE. THE KOMSOMOL IS APPARENTLY AFRAID THAT THESE GROUPS WILL FLOURISH AND UNDERMINE THE ACTIVITIES AND AUTHORITY OF THE KOMSOMOL.

MR. GORBACHEV APPARENTLY IS MEETING THAT OPPOSITION,
BECAUSE THE SUMMIT IS ON--BUT AT WHAT COST WE DO NOT KNOW.

MIKHAIL GORBACHEV IS NEITHER FRIEND NOR FOE BUT
THE LEADER OF ONE OF THE WORLD'S OTHER SUPER-POWERS. HE
HAS HIS AGENDA. IN PART, THAT AGENDA CORRESPONDS TO THE
INTERESTS OF THE UNITED STATES. IN PART, IT DIVERGES FROM IT.

THE EMPHASIS ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, CONSUMER GOODS, GLASNOST, MAY EXERT A COMPELLING FORCE ON SOVIET POLICIES.

If they are successful, they can produce a different Soviet outlook on the world and its problems.

CERTAINLY, ALL OF US MUST HOPE THAT THE SUPER-POWERS WILL BE ABLE TO DEVELOP SOME KIND OF ARMS REDUCTION PROGRAM WHICH WILL BE TRULY MEANINGFUL. THE ARMS RACE IS BREAKING THE ECONOMIES OF THE NATIONS OF THE WORLD. FACES MANKIND WITH THE REALITY OF SELF-DESTRUCTION.

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What we ought NOT do is to assume that the Soviet Union will change dramatically overnight.

CAN SHE RELAX HER CONTROL OF EASTERN EUROPE?

CAN SHE TURN AFGHANISTAN INTO A FINLAND-LIKE NEIGHBOR?

CAN SHE DEVELOP TIES WITH THIRD WORLD COUNTRIES DIFFERENT

FROM THOSE SHE HAS NOW WITH ANGOLA AND ETHIOPIA,

WHERE SHE IS BUSY TRANSFORMING THOSE SOCIETIES

INTO ONES MODELED AFTER THE OLD SOVIET WAY OF LIFE.

EVEN WITH ALL THESE DOUBTS, WE CANNOT BUT BE PLEASED THAT THE LEADER OF THE SOVIET UNION IS NOW SPEAKING WITH A DIFFERENT VOICE. Mr. GORBACHEV ENDED HIS SPEECH LAST MONDAY WITH THESE WORDS:

IT IS OUR DUTY TO PRESERVE OUR INIMITABLE HERITAGE

OF LIFE ON EARTH, TO HOLD REASON OVER NUCLEAR

INSANITY, TO CREATE ALL THE NECESSARY CONDITIONS

FOR THE FREE, ALL-AROUND DEVELOPMENT OF THE

INDIVIDUAL AND THE WHOLE OF HUMANITY. WE ARE

AWARE THAT THERE IS A POSSIBILITY FOR CONTINUOUS

PROGRESS AND REALIZE THAT IT IS NOT EASY TO

MEASURE IT. THIS DOES NOT FRIGHTEN US. ON THE

CONTRARY, THIS INPSIRES US, GIVING A LOFTY AND

HUMANE PURPOSE TO OUR LIVES, INJECTING IT WITH

A PROFOUND MEANING.

LET THIS BE THE REAL MIKHAIL GORBACHEV.
BUT DON'T COUNT ON IT.
