THE NEWS, ALMOST ALWAYS, INVOLVES A DEGREE OF VIOLENCE;
DURING 1987 THE NEWS WAS MADE LARGELY BY VIOLENCE IN THE
THIRD WORLD; THE IRAQ-IRAN STRUGGLE WENT INTO ITS SEVENTH
YEAR AND HAS ALREADY TAKEN OVER HALF A MILLION LIVES;
THE TAMIL-SRI LANKA ETHNIC STRUGGLE ~~WAS PUT DOWN ONLY BY THE INTRODUCTION OF THE INDIAN~~
~~ARMY AS A PEACE-KEEPING FORCE;~~ ERITREA AND ETHIOPIA
CONTINUED THEIR LONG BORDER WAR AND IN THE PROCESS MADE
IT DIFFICULT FOR THE WEST TO PROVIDE FOOD RELIEF FOR THE
STARVING PEASANTS AND THE POOR OF SUB-SAHARA AFRICA;

IN NICARAGUA THE SANDINISTA-CONTRA BATTLES CONTINUED.
NO SIDE SEEMS TO BE ABLE TO WIN A CLEAR VICTORY. THE
CONTRAS SEEM TO BE MAKING MORE GAIN IN THE MEDIA AND
THE SANDANISTAS HAVE POWER BUT HAVE MADE A BOTCH OF THE
ECONOMY; BOTH SIDES WERE PRESSED ~~BY THE~~ OTHER
NATIONS OF LATIN AMERICA TO SIGN A PEACE TREATY; NONE
WAS SIGNED;

IN ANGOLA THE SAVIMBI REBEL FORCES IN THE SOUTH MADE
PROGRESS AGAINST THE RUSSIAN- AND CUBAN-SUPPORTED GOVERNMENT
IN THE CAPITAL, BUT THERE IS AS YET NO DECISION IN FAVOR
OF ONE ~~OR~~ OR THE OTHER; IN SOUTH AFRICA THE RACIAL
STRUGGLE CONTINUED; THE SIDES SEEMED FURTHER APART THAN
EVER BEFORE. THE EMBARGO SEEMS TO HAVE HAD LITTLE EFFECT
ON THE AFRICAN ECONOMY AS IT WAS BEING VIOLATED ~~BY~~ SO
MANY COUNTRIES AND CORPORATIONS OF THE WORLD;

THERE WAS AN OCCASIONAL STRIKE ACTION AGAINST THE
 WHITE MAJORITY, BUT INCREASINGLY DURING THE YEAR
 THE BATTLES WERE BETWEEN BLACKS, AS THE ZULUS OF NATAL
 FOUGHT THE BANTU WHO SUPPORTED THE AFRICAN NATIONAL
 CONGRESS.

LEBANON CONTINUED TO BE A NO-MAN'S-LAND
 DIVIDED AMONG THE COMPETING FORCES OF CHRISTIANS,
 MUSLIMS, DRUZE, & OTHERS, WHICH WESTERNERS WOULD
 DO WELL TO AVOID IN THEIR TRAVELS. IT WAS A YEAR
 IN WHICH TERRY WAITE WENT TO THE LEBANON AS THE
 SPECIAL ENVOY OF THE ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY
 IN ORDER TO SECURE THE RELEASE OF THE HOSTAGES---
 & WAS HIMSELF TAKEN HOSTAGE & REMAINS A HOSTAGE.

IN THE PHILIPPINES THE AQUINO GOVERNMENT TRIED BOTH THE CARROT & THE STICK AGAINST REBEL TROOPS IN MANY OF THE ISLANDS. THEY PUT DOWN ONE MAJOR MILITARY ATTACK ON HER REGIME, ^{Thencefore} ~~but~~ ^{others} ~~later~~.

IN KOREA TUMULT, SHOUTING & KILLING PRECEDED THE ELECTION. KOREA HAD ITS ELECTION. HAITI DID NOT. HAITI GOT TO ITS ELECTION DAY, ALBEIT WITH DEATH & VIOLENCE, THEN FINALLY COULD NOT HOLD THE ELECTION BECAUSE OF ██████████ APPARENTLY GOVERNMENT-SPONSORED VIOLENCE.


ONE OF THE REASONS THAT THE THIRD WORLD WAS SO PROMINENT IN THE NEWS LAST YEAR WAS THAT THESE NATIONS WERE SCRAMBLING FOR THEIR DIMINISHED PIECE OF THE ECONOMIC PIE. THE POPULATION EXPLOSION HAS CAUGHT

THERE WAS THE EVER PREDICTABLE VIOLENCE IN NORTHERN IRELAND, BOMBINGS AND THE LIKE; THERE WAS THE PLO WITH THEIR PERIODIC ATTACKS ON ISRAEL; THERE WAS THE RUSSIAN INCURSION INTO AFGHANISTAN, ~~NOW IN ITS SEVENTH YEAR~~, A COSTLY MISTAKE FOR THE RUSSIANS WHICH THEY APPARENTLY WOULD LIKE TO GET OUT OF BUT DO NOT QUITE KNOW HOW TO DO.

NOT LONG AGO THE SUPER POWERS WERE INVOLVED IN MOST OF THE STRUGGLES OF THE WORLD, FROM EL SALVADOR AND NICARAGUA TO ~~LIBERIA~~ KAMPUCHEA AND ANGOLA; TODAY THIS SEEMS NOT TO BE THE CASE; MUCH OF THE NEWS IN 1987 ORIGINATED IN THE THIRD WORLD; THE WORLD IS NO LONGER BI-POLAR; EACH STRUGGLE ~~IN THE WORLD~~ DOES NOT NECESSARILY TRACE ITSELF BACK TO THE INTENTIONS OF A SUPER POWER; THE SUPER POWERS ARE INVOLVED IN MOST OF THE WORLD IN THE SENSE THAT THEIR NATIONAL SECURITY INTERESTS ~~ARE~~ MANDATE CERTAIN POSITIONS, BUT THEY ARE NO LONGER INVOLVED TO THE DEGREE THAT WOULD ENDANGER THE PEACE OF THE WORLD; THIRD WORLD POLITICS DO NOT BEGIN IN MOSCOW AND WASHINGTON; THEREFORE, THIRD WORLD UNREST ENDANGERS ONLY THE PEACE OF A SMALL PART OF THE WORLD;

ONE OF THE REASONS THAT THE THIRD WORLD WAS SO PROMINENT IN THE NEWS ~~LAST YEAR~~ WAS ~~THAT~~ THAT THESE NATIONS WERE SCRAMBLING FOR THEIR DIMINISHED PIECE OF THE ECONOMIC PIE; THE POPULATION EXPLOSION HAS CAUGHT

UP WITH ~~THEM~~ TODAY THERE ARE MORE THAN FIVE BILLION EARTHLINGS AND THE WORLD LACKS THE RESOURCES TO PROVIDE ADEQUATELY FOR ~~MANY~~ MOST OF THEM; THE INCREASE OF PRODUCTIVITY IN THE WORLD HAS DIMINISHED; IN THE 1960'S IT RAN ABOUT FIVE PERCENT; IN THE 1980'S IT HAS RUN BELOW TWO AND A HALF PERCENT, NOT ENOUGH TO PROVIDE FOR THOSE AT THE BOTTOM OF THE ECONOMIC LADDER;


SO WE HAVE THE SAD TALE OF THE DEBT INCURRED BY THE LATIN AND SOUTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES AND OTHERS. ~~THEY~~ IN THE 1970'S PERU, THE ARGENTINE, BRAZIL AND MEXICO ALL UNDERTOOK BILLIONS OF DOLLARS OF DEBT FOR A VARIETY OF PROJECTS WITHOUT ANY IDEA OF HOW THEY WOULD BE REPAYED OR WHETHER THESE PROJECTS WERE WHAT THEIR COUNTRY ^{IES} REALLY NEEDED; AND THERE IS NOW NO WAY FOR THEIR DEBTS ^{TO BE} REPAYED WITHOUT TAKING IT OUT OF THE ALREADY DISMALLY LOW STANDARD OF LIVING OF THEIR CITIZENS, WHO ARE AMONG THE POOREST ^{IN} THE WORLD;

MANY OF THESE COUNTRIES ARE BALKING AT REPAYING THEIR DEBTS AND THEIR UNWILLINGNESS AND INABILITY TO REPAY THREATENS THE ^{STABILITY} ~~STABILITY~~ OF THE WHOLE ^{INTERNATIONAL} ~~INTERNATIONAL~~ BANKING SYSTEM; WHAT IS OWED TO THE BANKS REPRESENTS MUCH OF THEIR CAPITALIZATION; THIS IS A NO-WIN SITUATION ON ALL SIDES; THE COUNTRIES ARE SAYING THAT THEY CAN AND WILL PROVIDE ONLY A CERTAIN PERCENTAGE OF ~~THEIR~~ ^{THEIR} GROSS NATIONAL PRODUCT AS PAYMENT AGAINST THE LOAN; THE BANKS ARE BEING PRESSED TO MAKE FURTHER LOANS, BRIDGE LOANS OR TO TAKE GOODS IN PAYMENT OF FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS;

THE WEST, PARTICULARLY THE UNITED STATES, ~~IS~~ ^{IS} FINANCIALLY STRAITENED AND CANNOT THINK OF EMBARKING ON MAJOR FOREIGN AID PROGRAMS; YET, THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT IS BEING CALLED UPON ~~TO~~ TO SUPPORT ALL OR MOST OF THE EXISTING ~~DEBT~~ ^{THIRD WORLD} DEBT;

IT'S A SAD STORY WITH SOME JUSTICE ON ALL SIDES; THE DEBTOR COUNTRIES CANNOT AFFORD TO REPAY THEIR DEBTS/AND MAINTAIN A MINIMAL STANDARD OF LIVING FOR THEIR PEOPLE; THE BANKS CANNOT AFFORD TO SWALLOW ~~THE~~ ^{THE} MULTI-BILLION DOLLARS OF DEBT WHICH THEY INCURRED ~~OUT~~ OUT OF GREED AND OUT OF THE DESIRE OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT IN THE 60'S AND 70'S TO AID THESE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES; THE GOVERNMENT WHICH ENCOURAGED THE DEBT IN THE FIRST PLACE IS SEEKING A WAY OUT, BUT THE OPTIONS ARE FEW;

WE DON'T THINK OF 1987 AS A WARLIKE YEAR, BUT IT WAS; WE DON'T THINK OF IT AS A WARLIKE YEAR BECAUSE THERE WAS NO WAR BETWEEN THE TRADITIONAL EUROPEAN RIVALS; BUT THERE WAS WAR THROUGHOUT THE WORLD, ~~AND~~ MOST ^{NOTABLY} ~~NOTABLY~~ BETWEEN IRAN AND IRAQ, A STRUGGLE WHICH GOES NOW INTO ITS ~~NINTH~~ ^{NINTY} SEVENTH YEAR WITHOUT ANY SIGNS OF ENDING; THE ARAB LEAGUE, THE UNITED NATIONS AND OTHER GROUPS HAVE TRIED DESPERATELY TO PUT AN END TO THIS WAR WHICH HAS DECIMATED THE ECONOMY AND THE POPULATION OF THE TWO COUNTRIES, BUT SO FAR TO NO AVAIL; ASAD, THE IRAQI HEAD, WANTS TO PUT AN END TO THE WAR, BUT HE ~~STARTED IT.~~ ^{STARTED IT.} AND THE AYATOLLAH KHOMEINI REPEATS HIS ORIGINAL DEMANDS: ~~THE~~

ONE MORNING IN SEPTEMBER, THE U.S. NAVAL SHIP, THE STARK, WAS HIT BY AN IRAQI FIGHTER PLANE. THE UNITED STATES TOOK THIS AS AN INDICATION THAT THE WATERS OF THE GULF HAD TO BE PATROLLED & ANNOUNCED IT WAS REFLAGGING A NUMBER OF KUWAITI TANKERS, GRANTING THEM THE PROTECTION OF AMERICAN MILITARY SUPPORT.

SO FAR THE PLAN SEEMS TO HAVE WORKED.

AFTER A SINGLE REFLAGGED TANKER WAS BOMBARDED IN THE FIRST DAYS OF THIS NEW PLAN, AMERICAN-FLAGGED SHIPS HAVE PASSED THROUGH THE STRAITS WITHOUT INCIDENT. OTHER SHIPS FROM OTHER COUNTRIES HAVE NOT. FUNDAMENTALISM IS ESSENTIALLY A MOVEMENT OF RETURN ---TO THE VALUES OF AN OLDER SOCIETY, ~~AN~~ AN ATTEMPT TO TURN THE COMMUNITY BACK TO THE VALUES OF THE PAST. IT IS/A DENIAL OF MODERN LIFE. FUNDAMENTALISM IS PARTICULARLY STRONG TODAY
IN THE ARAB WORLD, WHERE IT VERY OFTEN REPRESENTS
A POLITICAL UNDERGROUND AS WELL ^{AS} A RELIGIOUS MOVEMENT.
THOSE WHO OPPOSE THEIR PRESENT GOVERNMENTS COMBINE
FUNDAMENTALISM WITH POLITICAL ACTION. SO YOU HAVE
BROTHERHOODS OF PIETY AND OTHER SUCH GROUPS IN
ALMOST ALL ARAB STATES TODAY, WITH MANY OF THEIR LEADERS
IN JAIL.

A GOVERNMENT FRIENDLY TO THE SOVIET UNION WAS INSTALLED;






