The second of the propositions which we have undertaken to discuss in this analysis of basic Jewish affirmation should read: The Right to Worth Doing.

In our society we unconsciously and unreservedly assume this to be so. The pattern of our internal morality is geared toward a acceptance of the responsibility of being good and doing good. The good deed and the dictum of one boy scouts might be cited to exemplify our moral attitude towards service and right living. Such an attitude, in so far as it is interiorized, is, of course, wholly commendable. No nation can advance unselfishly in its own moral growth. What robbery and strength when self interest is its only moral guide. What robbery and strength our nation has been able to show in its unprecedented destruction - the aggressor and from the fact that many of its citizens have affirmed even from the fact that many of its citizens have governed their lives by principle of service rather than principle of self. Whenever it can robbery political greed and economic rights of ~~the~~ principles, living made even the applier conscious of his social obligation. Carnegie and Rockefellers billowing wealth has been made at the cost of many lives and much suffering; it remains one of the happy and significant paradoxes of human history that so much of that wealth was late placed to the public's benefit. That so much of that wealth was late placed to the public's benefit. ~~that will our wonderful opportunity society to serve us extended period in which apathy and indifference a ready rationalistic period when we allow self interest to govern us and concern ourselves only with our personal gain - even if unscrupulous ambition predominates in such a period - we if we are a cause should it moral indifference and societal gain of sympathy by unscrupulous church attendants and ecclesiastical support.~~

Satan shall take on Job, God most trusted servant on earth, and by to entice him from his right way. - Then, said the Devil ^{Book} in a voice intended to rouse him Book intended to rouse him to the philosophical problem, Satan a task he once accepted now and Job has profited much from serving God. BOTH JOBS serve God for nought. Because of it he has been blessed with children and children and health. So God allows Satan to take all these from Job, sparing only his life. Virtue and right action are their own reward

Many were unsatisfied with the proposition that Right is worth Doing because virtue is taken to one's debt for duty - the pleasure we feel in accomplished and service. The task is to find the balance of the scales in the next world - a theologian to satisfy Job would never admit but an interesting vision of paradise to many generations of honest believers and a fearful vision of eternal torment to many generations of cruel and base-minded of eternal torment to many generations of cruel and base-minded humanity. Dante Dante Alighieri lay the ^{hell of} attribution and reward out with great uprightness and great astuteness ^{to pain} of the Christian and Mosques and even synagogues grew out of Christian Christianity and proselytization. What was at first a misunderstanding became an all engrossing concern. Theological subtleties became an all engrossing concern. The worth of right living took over - the problem of punishments ^{right} - the practical problem of how to live men's minds away from the practical problem of how to live.

Rabbinic Judaism was not averse to the infliction of reward & punishment in the next life. But it never allowed it either to prevail or stand punished, or salvation only through the threat, or to feel that ritual or study alone would ensure one safety. And did, help and charity predominant were only means to an end and then man ~~not~~ we not happily adored.

Maimonide faced with the problem says that the provincial teacher ought to awaken men to basic things. The other first son finds a school who is given him some sweets, then soon finds, the teacher will give him a good or bad report and who could put him in disgrace at home or prevent his son studying for the profession - finally when he is far enough along so that he can & he studies willingly and gladly out of love for them and a desire to merit them so that he may ~~the~~ ~~justify~~ himself and see his fellows too.

be kind & gentle - however & cruelty is not the mark of a gentleman
nor should he be domineered with an overbearing social consciousness.

Or that it is permissible to close my eyes to the effect of my business
on the welfare of the whole community; but philanthropy and
charity of course are old falls down the nests.

Or it may be interpreted to mean that it is important to be sympathetic toward and upholding the less honored of society - mediocre ability - to be kind and be gentle ~~man~~ - because ~~man~~ cruelty is not a mark of true gentleness nor of generous men.

Or it may be construed to mean that charity is a special form of living engaged in it designated term. I shall close my eyes to the effects of my business upon the welfare of the whole community; but philanthropy and giving founder of commerce Daniel Smith -

But how the simple word "right" comes twisted out of shape until now as bad as it - justification for some unequal status quo or some undesirable form of government. Three quarters of a century ago the German philosopher ^{Nietzsche} shocked the civilized world with his thesis on right and wrong from an evolved self interest; Nietzsche was one of the first to systematically and strikingly set out in naked terms. For the Germans all were to do to do to red it out in naked purity. For the Germans all were action which we loved - sympathy or benevolence or justice (or all that we would call right) are simply unnecessary concessions that we must call right - a morality created by the need on the part of the strong toward a morality created by the need and the effects for that our punishment and to excuse the sins of the people for that our punishment and to excuse the sins of the people when our sins be greater. Civilization must make the people when our sins be greater. Civilization must make the people when our sins be greater according to his writings of Darwin on the strongest and fittest to survive. If we want a brave new world - if we want to do what is right we must rid our minds of ~~all~~ day-long

as bound morally - we might have been to ride rough-shod
over the weak and fulfill our destiny by the inevitable process
of exploitation. What is interesting is all the futile permission





Mordecai Oren has corroborated Slansky's close connections with Zionist organizations and with the Israeli legation. Oren also confirmed that all Zionist campaigns were conducted under Slansky's protection. The witness Oskar Langer, an international Zionist agent, also confirmed that Slansky was the patron of all Jewish bourgeois nationalists and that he expressly said that it was necessary to fill important positions in economic, political, and public life with Zionists and Jewish bourgeois nationalists. According to Slansky, their bourgeois class background could be disregarded. His closest associates from the days of his youth were Geminder, Frejka, Reicin, and Slingall Titoist agents.

Slansky cannot deny his Jewish bourgeois nationalist character. If we realize the true meaning of Jewish bourgeois nationalism, from which the international Zionist organizations, the most important agencies of American imperialism, are descended, we understand why Rudolf Slansky finds himself today a prisoner in court, charged with the gravest crimes in our penal code.....

It will be necessary for me to go into details of this so-called Zionist movement. One of the reasons for this is that eleven of the defendants have been trained by Zionist organizations. Another reason is that the trial shows to all Communist and workers' parties the danger of Zionism as an agency of U.S. imperialism. The Zionist organizations have always had close links with world capitalism...

The dangerous character of the international Zionist organizations increased after the setting up of a U.S. satellite, the so-called State of Israel. Even after the setting up of the State of Israel the main seat of Zionist organizations remained in the United States, where the Zionists are strongly represented among the U.S. monopolists, who are laying down the whole aggressive policy of the United States. The Ben Gurion government, which has sold out to its U.S. providers, is transforming Israel into a military base for U.S. aggression.

The Zionist agents in Slansky's conspiratorial center served mainly the U.S. aims of world domination and aggression, not the working people of Israel, by their criminal activities. Cosmopolitanism and Jewish bourgeois nationalism are in fact only two sides of the same coin, and a bad coin at that.

The building of socialism is contrary to their class interests. The Zionist

movement is not some kind of an idea, some sort of an ideology. In the 4th Book of our Bible, The Book of Numbers, we read a strange somewhat puerile -- yet compelling story. The tribes of Israel led by Moses are on the march. Always the Canaanites tried to bar the privilege of peaceful passage. Messengers were sent to the King of Moab, when the Bible tells us now a certain BALAK who was of a PROPHET requesting transit right. Balak was unwilling to allow the Jews passage, and yet he was not of a mind to face them in open battle. He had heard too many reports of our strength and skill with the sword. Balak devised another scheme to halt the Jews advance -- a plan which would have appealed only to a man steeped in the primitive fear and superstition of the desert regions.




