
Dear Adele,


I will need the index back from you by next Monday or Tuesday. If your corrections are minor, you can call them in to me instead of mailing the whole index, which would save us some time.

Dear Cheryl,

I wish the Index had been as simple a task as you'd expected it to be. The indexer did not know the difference between Talmud and Talmud Torah, or between peshet (the plural is pesharim) and peshat, two errors that gave me pause about the entire Index. I've corrected those two errors, tried to check everything else within reason, and live in mild fear that there are other errors I haven't yet learned enough to catch. In any event, this is much more marked up than you'd anticipated (and took much more time than I had). You can see why I couldn't phone in corrections and why this is slightly delayed--I simply couldn't make it by the deadline I'd set myself for the entire proof yesterday, and I wasn't willing to hold that huge packet up for this small one.
