





CHART 1. CHRONOLOGICAL LANDMARKS OF THE ANCIENT NEAR EASTERN PERIOD

General History	Israel and its Antecedents
c. 3100. Invention of cuneiform writing by the Sumerians in southern Mesopotamia.	
c. 2615-2175. Old Kingdom period of Egyptian history (building of the pyramids).	
c. 2360-2180. First large-scale territorial empire in Mesopotamian history: Sargon of Akkad.	
21st-19th centuries. Movement of Amorites and other barbarian peoples into the settled areas of Mesopotamia and Canaan.	21st-15th centuries. Middle Bronze Age in Canaan; probable origins of the patriarchal traditions of Israel.
2060-1950. Third Dynasty of Ur.	
1792-1750. Reign of Hammurabi of Babylon.	1678-1570. Canaan and Egypt ruled by the Hyksos; possible setting for the descent of Israel's ancestors to Egypt.
