A Few Facts About Geneva-on-the-Lake, O.

Geneva-on-the-Lake is on the Shore of Lake Erie

- 4 miles north of Geneva, Ohio
- 10 miles west of Ashtabula
- 47 miles east of Cleveland
- 130 miles north and west of Pittsburgh

Accessible by paved roads in all directions from your home. Drive to U. S. Route 20, or by N. Y. C. and N. Y. C. & St. L. R. R. to Geneva, Ohio, and by taxi to the resort.

Follow U. S. Route 20 to Geneva, Ohio, turn north at Geneva on Route 534 to the resort. Or, take Greyhound Bus from Ashtabula to Geneva or Cleveland to Geneva and taxi from Geneva to the resort.



Accommodations

at Geneva-on-the-Lake

Numerous high class Resort Hotels operating on the American Plan cater to a select patronage of white Gentile people. Rates run from \$24 to \$45 per person per week, depending upon accommodations offered. Hotels have all conveniences and are conducted in an efficient, orderly manner for your safety and happiness.

There are many rooming houses where a comfortable bedroom or bedrooms are available at reasonable prices.

Hundreds of furnished cottages surround the business section. These are for rent by the week, month or season at prices from \$20 per week for a room cottage, 3 or 4 blocks from the lake, up to \$75.00 per week for beautiful cottages right on the bank of Lake Erie. All have city water and toilet. Reservations should be made in advance thru a Geneva Realtor or Owner.

There are well stocked food stores, restaurants, etc. at the resort and at Geneva village, where you can purchase your supplies.

Safe Vacations

Geneva-on-the-Lake is an incorporated village with a well trained police force, fire department and life guards to keep the resort safe under all conditions. Your family will be safe here.

There are no war plants, no manufacturing, no army or navy or air maneuvers in this vicinity.

Streets are paved and there are cement sidewalks. There's a modern, sanitary sewage system, city water, electric lights and gas, and the municipality collects the garbage and refuse, and cleans the beach.



Amusements

First is the Lake—it's clean, free from disease and tested regularly; the bathing beach is safe and patroled by life guards for further protection. Speed boats operate daily for pleasure rides. Canoes and row boats with outboard motors are available for rent at moderate cost.

A splendid 9-hole Golf Course owned by the resort is operated as a public course; daily, weekly or season green's fees charged.

Dancing every night at the Pier a fine, large, modern dance palace with many big name bands each season.



Geneva, Ohio

is 4 miles south of Geneva-on-the-Lake, on U. S. Route 20 and on main lines of N. Y. C. and Nickle Plate R. R. Geneva is a white American village of 4200 people. A solid year-around community in which to make a permanent home.

Its chief industries are: The American Fork & Hoe Co., manufacturers of garden tools and the famous True Temper Fish Rods and golf shafts; The Champion Hardware Co. manufacturers of light builders hardware and gray iron castings; The Geneva Metal Wheel Co. manufacturers of steel wheels. They have a normal pay roll of over 1000 employees.




