It is my assumption that she met Daniel and Raphael Silver through the Temple and Rabbi Silver.

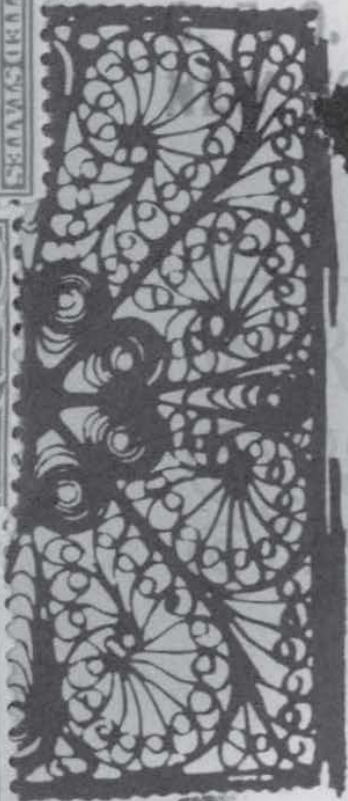
I'd be interested to learn more of the connection between Mrs. Auerbach and the Silvers.
