New York, Nov. 24 1863

My dear good Caroline & Children

We sail at 3 o'clock P.M. to morrow on U.S. mail Steamer Creole for New Orleans.

I did not calculate to write until I get on board & then write daily but somehow another I feel, perhaps you want to hear if but a little from me. I sent you a piece of Muslin by Cohn. I also have \$75 Seventy five Dollars here with Mess. Jaraslosky Brothers which you can draw of Cohn.

If the Trade I say but little.

How are the children? How is Hamlin and Does Hattie talk of my yet? Write soon direct your letter M.M. Spiegel care C. Herzer & Co. New Orleans.
