# Sweeny's Hotel,

New-York, Nov 24 1863

My dear good Caroline  
& Children

We sail at 3 o'clock  
P. M. to morrow on U.S.  
mail steamer "Proctor"  
for New Orleans,  
I did not calculate  
to write until I get

another I feel perhaps

by Coburn, I also have  
\$75 Seventy five Dollars
